Our interventions provide **LEADERSHIP, EDUCATION,** and **ENTERPRISE** development support for youths. We recognise strongly that youths are the future and play a vital role towards nation-building and economic growth.



Our transformational programs prepare youths to develop the right values, reframe their personalities to lead themselves and empower them to become more responsible to lead positive change in their communities.

Since its inception in 2016, REVAMP Africa (formerly Project Revamp Africa)'s programmes have reached over 180,036 youths directly across 30 states in Nigeria.

# the problem...



One of the prevailing problems in Nigeria is the high rate of poverty with unemployment being its major root cause. IMF statistics reveal that women constitute over 60% of the poorest people in Nigeria.

The high poverty rate causes many young girls to be cajoled and sometimes forced into early marriages due to economic reasons.

The huge fallback in technology education in Nigeria is evident, especially among the female gender. This inequality has led to unfavourable employment opportunities, financial incapacitation, deprived rights, forced early marriages, lowered self-esteem, to mention a few for young girls and women.

Many Nigerian female youth lives with too much dependence for survival.

## SheTech Digital Inclusion Programme

Our SheTech Boot Camp is a professional program that aims to accelerate digital and life skills for girls and women living in underserved communities in Nigeria.

Our initiative is focused on equipping them with technical, soft, and business skills to enable them to become self-employed or employable. The skills acquired by the girls and women will give them easy access to the market, providing them with employable jobs or the ability to start, manage, and expand their businesses.

Our ultimate objective is to provide a platform that allows them to become self-sufficient and pursue their dreams without relying solely on external financial support.

## SHETECH DIGITAL INCLUSION PROGRAMME



Our SheTech Boot Camp will enable them:

- Learn basic tech skills on Website Design, Social Media Management, Social Media Marketing and Business Development Skills.
- Empower the girls and women to start a career in tech or learn more tech related courses in the university.
- Earn income from skills developed through employment opportunities or starting their small tech-based businesses.
- Female youths would be empowered to be self-sustainable to support their dreams, during financial challenges.

# Programme Components

The SHETECH BOOT CAMP empowers young girls and women with digital and life skills, to enable them start up small businesses, become financially sustainable or build a career in tech.

## Classroom Based Workshops

The female youths will learn through facilitator-led workshops, training sessions, group work and reflective personal assessments. The workshops will be delivered over 10-14 days for easier impact and implementation. Female youths will learn on Website Development/Design, Social Media Management/Advertising, Graphics Design, Business Skills, Life Skills, etc.

## Internship Opportunities

Through our Internship programme, we connect participants to job opportunities, where they can learn how best to utilise their skills gained and improve their learning experience. This helps deepen the learning experience for some of the participants.



## Coaching and Mentoring

Seasoned professionals will serve as coaches and mentors to the participants; supporting their holistic development, building more skills and providing feedback on the progress they are making throughout the duration of the programme.

## Community Change Projects

As part of our development program, the young leaders would work as a team to champion community development projects and kick start initiatives that positively impact their immediate community as a form of give-back.
