Together, we are empowering students to build confidence, understand the world around them, and acquire essential life skills to become critical thinkers and problem solvers for the 21st century.

It was incredible to see the continuation of these programmes during the first wave considering the logistics required to deliver in accordance with the requirements of the new academic calendar. Facilitators and students have bonded which is testament to the impact our programmes are making in supporting quality and relevant education. Students have played an active role since the beginning and have proved once again their ability to find creative lasting solutions, get curious and ability to reflect with their peers on further challenges.

We are pleased to say that this wave of programmes reached 251 students within the age range of 10 -15 years, it commissioned 5 facilitators and 4 staff to deliver and worked alongside 4 schools throughout the Ga West District.
