

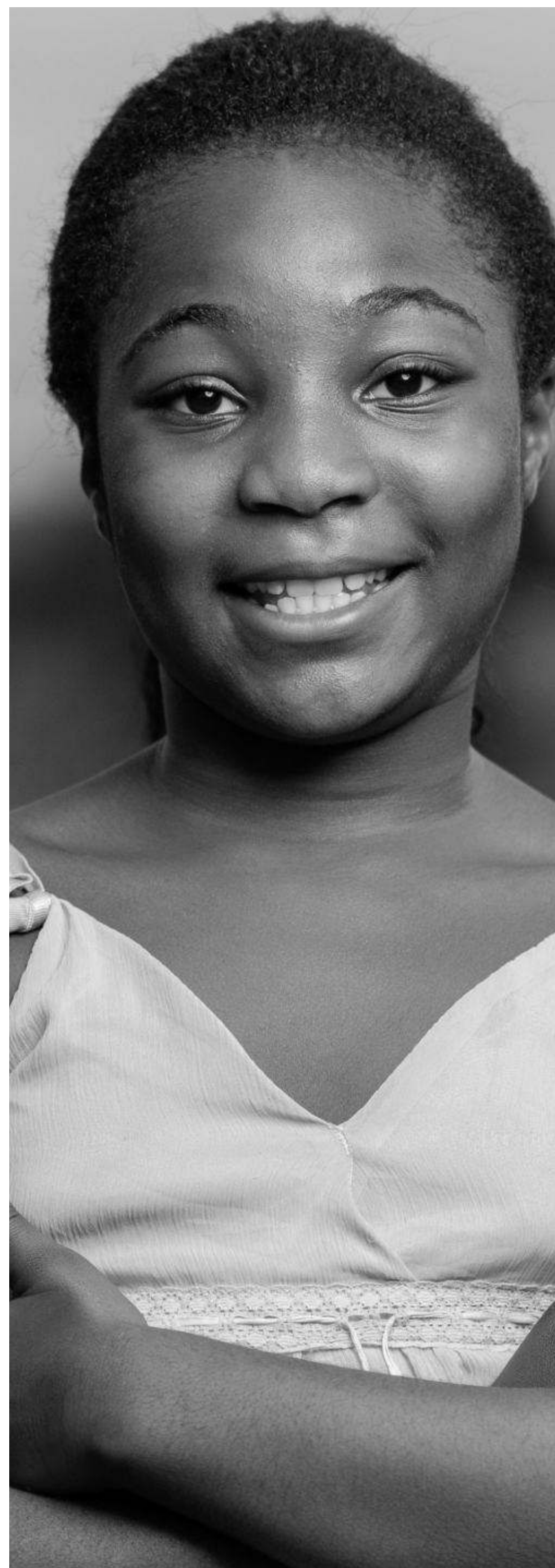

In less than 2 years since our inception, The Glow Foundation has achieved remarkable milestones in our mission to empower communities. Here's a glimpse into our accomplishments:

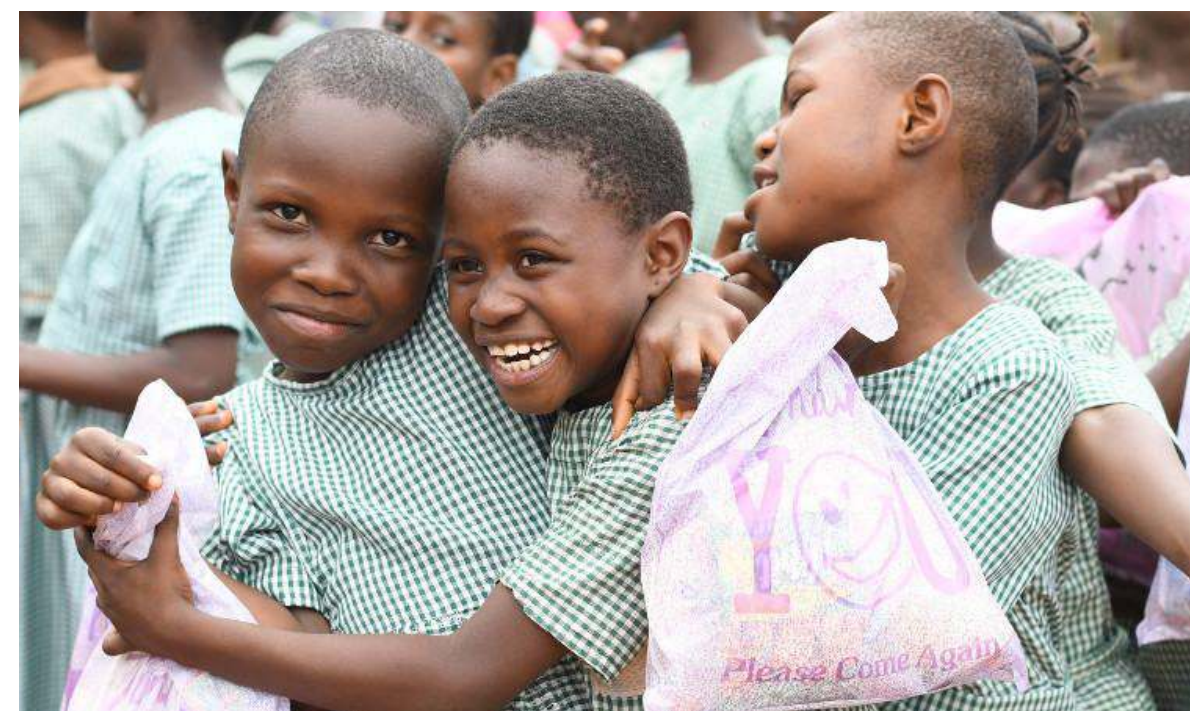


1. SPREADING LOVE TO 1000 STREET KIDS

In September 2022, a non-profit initiative reached 1000 street kids in Makoko and Festac Link Bridge Slum. Across two impactful days, it enhanced education, empowered future leaders, engaged with the community, met basic needs, and fostered personal growth. By providing educational materials and inspiring aspirations, the project aimed for sustained positive change. Through partnerships, it ensured lasting impact beyond its duration. Benefiting both recipients and the project team, it served as a transformative experience, nurturing personal growth and teamwork skills.

2. CHRISTMAS MEMORIES

Completed on December 15th, 2022, in the Jakande/Isolo Axis, a collaborative humanitarian initiative supported Mrs. NKIRU OKI's family in partnership with The Uncle Sele Foundation. Mrs. NKIRU OKI, facing challenges due to her husband's partial stroke and her son Victor's cerebral palsy, received vital assistance. The support included covering house rent (N180,000), education fees (N25,000), weekly physiotherapy for Victor (N10,000 per week for a year), food, medication, specialized diet, personal care, and a memorable Christmas celebration. This comprehensive aid provided stability and improved the family's quality of life significantly.



3. SPREADING LOVE TO 5000 CHILDREN IN SLUMS AND DILAPIDATED SCHOOLS

"Glow in Lagos" reached over 2500 children in Dustbin Village and Makoko/Iwaya Slum, offering emotional support, counseling, and distributing back-to-school items. In Ibadan, the initiative impacted over 1300 children across multiple schools, providing learning materials, school bags, and emotional support. "Glow in Ogun State" visited two schools, conducting sessions on critical thinking and distributing essential items to over 1000 children and their parents. The project, funded with nearly \$30,000, successfully reached over 5000 children, significantly improving their lives through education and emotional support.

4. PROJECT 4: EMPOWERX

On November 18th, 2023, Empower X embarked on a Love Trip to Jebba Community in Ebute Metta, Lagos state, aiming to uplift its overlooked residents. The community, plagued by respiratory diseases and child labor, lacks basic amenities. Empower X's objective was clear: empower Jebba's children with knowledge and resources for a better future. Key milestones included puberty education, menstrual hygiene workshops, team-building activities, life skills workshops, and community engagement with local leaders. With the support of partners like Donors for Africa, Kotex Nigeria, and Perry Pays, making a lasting impact on the lives of Jebba's children.



5. PROJECT 5: HEARTFELT VALENTINE

On February 14th, 2024, The Glow Foundation and The Love Walk Foundation partnered to celebrate Valentine's Day in the Orile/Doyin community, Lagos, aiming to make it special for over 50 young girls. This initiative, rooted in the core values of partnership and collaboration, provided the girls with sanitary pads, flowers, food, drinks, and gifts, focusing on empowerment and creating memorable experiences. This Heartfelt Valentine project reflects a commitment to spreading love and support among underprivileged children.

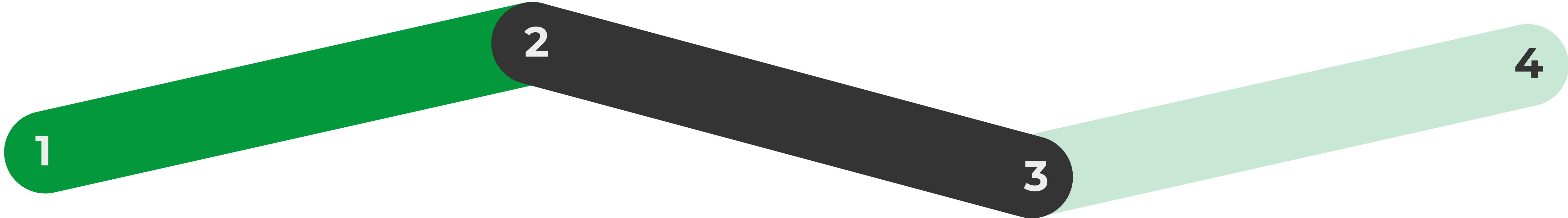
