

Progress Report: Beekeeping Initiative

Introduction

This report outlines the progress made during the month of September 2024 for the Beekeeping Initiative in Tansen Municipality-8, Palpa. The primary focus was on training local residents in beekeeping practices and enhancing their skills to promote sustainable livelihoods.

Funds Received

During this reporting period, PA Nepal received a disbursement of \$1,200. This amount is crucial for continuing our efforts, especially as we strive to cover ongoing project expenses.

Allocation of Funds

The disbursed amount was managed carefully to address the most urgent needs of the initiative:

- **Training Sessions:** A significant portion of the funds was allocated to conducting training sessions for local beekeepers. These sessions are essential for equipping participants with the knowledge and skills required for successful beekeeping.
- **Beekeeping Equipment:** We utilized part of the funds to purchase necessary beekeeping equipment, including hives, protective gear, and tools, which are vital for establishing productive hives.



- **Community Workshops:** A portion of the funds was also directed towards organizing community workshops to raise awareness about the importance of beekeeping and environmental sustainability.

Challenges

The ongoing rainy season has presented significant challenges for the project, impacting the timely implementation of training sessions and community outreach efforts. Additionally, the project is still in its early stages, and we face difficulties in reaching all community members due to limited resources. The need for continuous education and support remains high.

- Economic Empowerment: The training and resources provided have started to enhance local incomes through increased honey production, offering families a sustainable livelihood.
- Environmental Awareness: The initiative has fostered greater awareness of environmental conservation among participants, encouraging sustainable practices in their daily lives.
