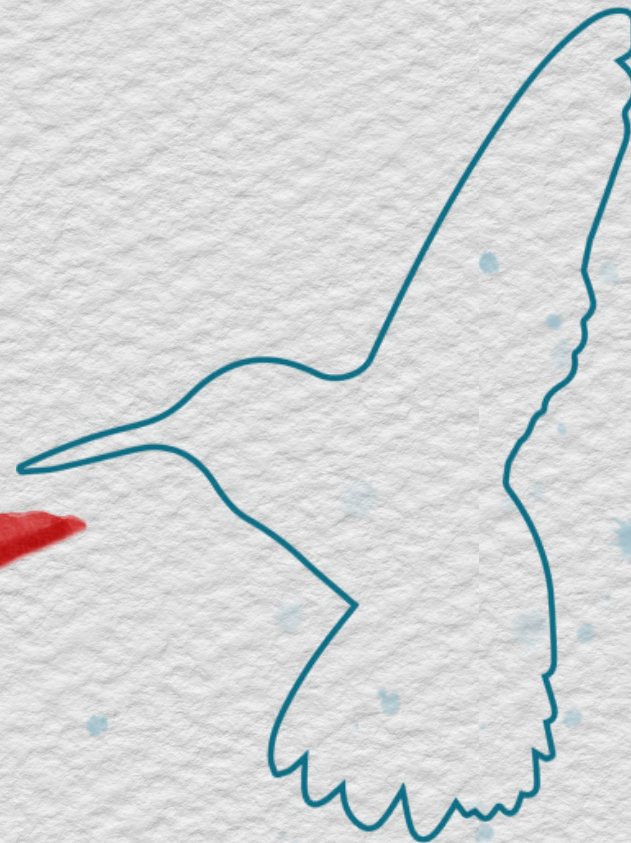


Rede Cultural Beija-Flor

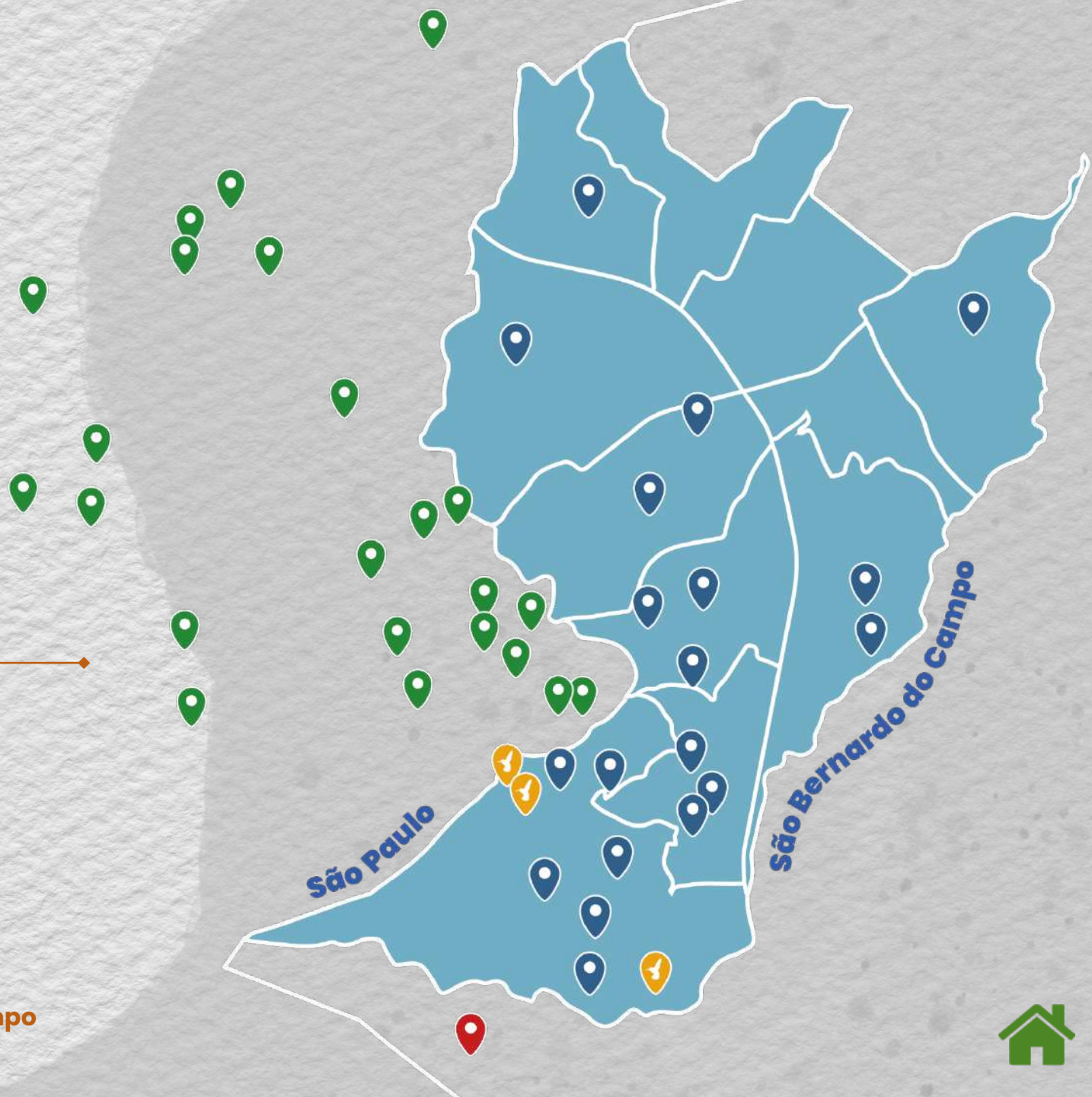

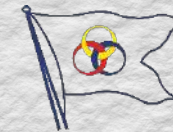
