Summary

The project aims to improve access to healthcare for children, women, and the entire rural population of 1,500. The project will provide a place where 816 children, 425 women, the elderly, and 1,500 rural residents will finally have access to basic healthcare. No more long, dangerous journeys for pregnant women. No more mothers relying on unsafe herbal remedies. No more preventable deaths. The health center will:

- ✓ Provide life-saving antenatal care to pregnant women
- ✓ Reduce maternal and infant mortality
- ✓ Ensure children get the medical attention they need
- ✓ Offer healthcare to the elderly and vulnerable populations

Project update

Thanks to your generous support, we have achieved significant progress in bringing healthcare closer to the Bakwa community. The installation of sanitary fittings in the restrooms has been completed, while flooring is ongoing.

Next steps

We are eager to continue the momentum and complete the remaining aspects of the project, including:

- Complete Flooring
- Equipping the facility and furniture
- Conduct a community health promotion, including free HIV, HBV, HCV, and NCDs screening of community dwellers and handover of the facility to the beneficiaries.

Challenges faced

- Difficulties in transporting purchased materials due to the lack of road infrastructure. Materials are being transported by the community dwellers through head-transport, slowing the progress of the work. In addition, the activities of non-state armed groups continue to pose accessibility risks.
- Increase in the cost of materials and labor due to inflation.
