### When to Apply

The application window will open on February 10th, 2025 and stay open until 11:59pm, March 7th 2025

### Funding Priorities

Losses of equipment or infrastructure from Hurricane Beryl are considered for Grants up to \$1500 USD

Equipment, infrastructure or technology upgrades for increased disaster resiliency are considered for Grants up to \$3000 USD.

Fees to cover trainings, courses and conferences to further your professional development  
Up to \$2000
