1. Introduction

This report outlines the outcomes of a project aimed at providing therapeutic interventions to children with disabilities. The initiative was supported by financial assistance received through the Global Giving platform. The project focused on improving the physical, cognitive, and emotional well-being of 10 children with varying disabilities through individualized therapy plans for duration of six months.

2. Objective

To deliver essential therapeutic services—such as physiotherapy, occupational therapy, and speech therapy—to children with disabilities in order to improve their quality of life, enhance their independence, and promote their inclusion in society.

3. Beneficiaries

A total of **10 children with disabilities** were directly benefitted from the project. The disabilities addressed included:

- Autism Spectrum Disorder
- Intellectual Disabilities
- Speech and Language Delays



4. Activities Conducted

S. No.	Activity Type	Frequency	Total Sessions Conducted
1	Physiotherapy	3 sessions/week	120+
2	Occupational Therapy	3 sessions/week	120+
3	Speech and Language Therapy	3 sessions/week	120+
4	Parental Counseling	Bi-Monthly	5 sessions
5	Progress Assessments	Quarterly	3 rounds

Each child received a customized plan after a detailed assessment. The therapies were conducted by trained professionals in a supportive and inclusive environment.



5. Impact Achieved

- **Improved Motor Skills:** 7 children showed significant improvement in gross and fine motor skills.
- **Better Communication:** 4 non-verbal children began to express themselves through gestures or simple words.
- **Increased Independence:** Daily living skills like feeding, dressing, and toileting improved in 6 children.
- **Parental Empowerment:** Parents received training on home-based care and strategies to continue progress beyond therapy hours.
