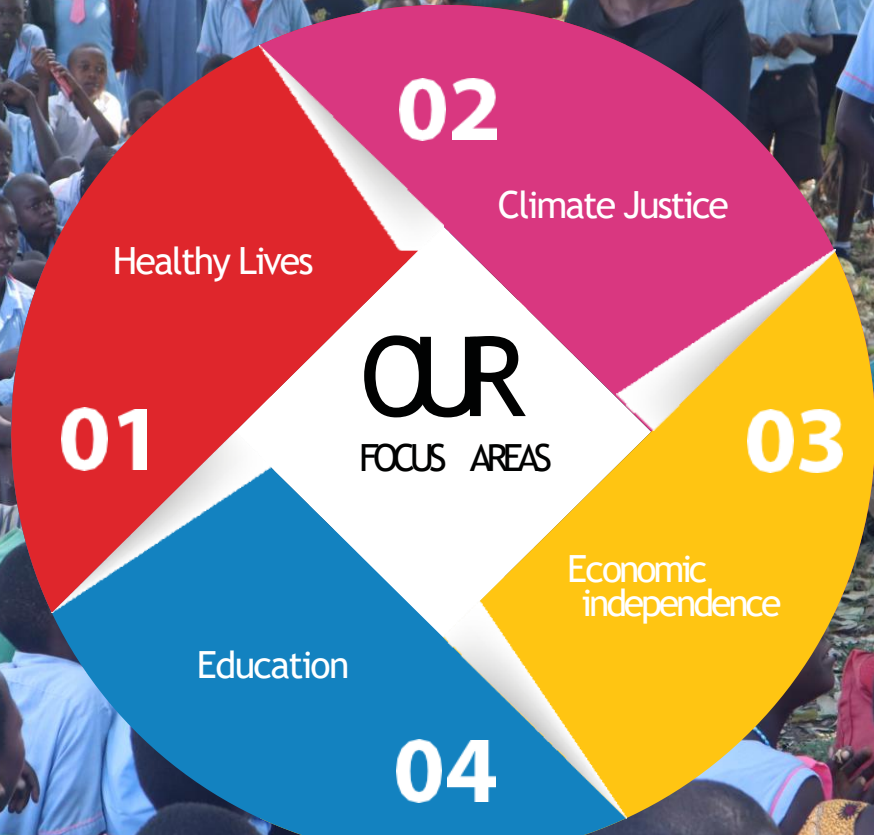

MENTAL HEALTH

Speakoutu offers free early detection and counselling services to young people faced with mental distress through an online platform that is easily accessible by young people. The patients can easily follow up with the counsellor on the platform anytime. People whose conditions have been flagged to be serious are connected to mental health specialists near them for special care. The platform also provides information on a wide range of mental health conditions like anxiety, depression among others. The platform is the first of its kind in Uganda to deliver mental health care using a digital platform. The platform is easily accessible by anyone with an internet connection or phone.

ASRH PROGRAM

Adolescent Sexual and Reproductive Health Program targets young people, to prevent gender-based violence, improve sexual and reproductive health outcomes and promote gender equality. This program is designed by young people for young people. Through the use of peer educators, theatre performances, and community-based parliaments, young people are able to easily access resources and knowledge in a youth-friendly manner.



GIRLS PARLIAMENT

The program advances girls' leadership by facilitating PARLIAMENTS through which girls & women advocate with key stakeholders to design strategies that are aimed at empowering communities to end gender inequalities and child marriages.

Empower NeXT

This is a youth-led advocacy model that targets adolescents and youth to empower them by delivering stigma-free and rights-affirming information and products on issues of health, sexuality and human rights

YOUTH VOICES

Youth Voice empowers and amplifies young people's voices to advocate for policy reforms by engaging policy and decision makers at community, district and national level to prioritize young people's access to quality Sexual and Reproductive Health services.

Sisters Circle Mentorship Program

This is a school program that provides continuous learning and growth environment for girls. It emphasizes leadership development, self-confidence, community impact, and skills enhancement, all within a nurturing 'sister circle' of mentors and peers dedicated to positive transformation and empowerment.

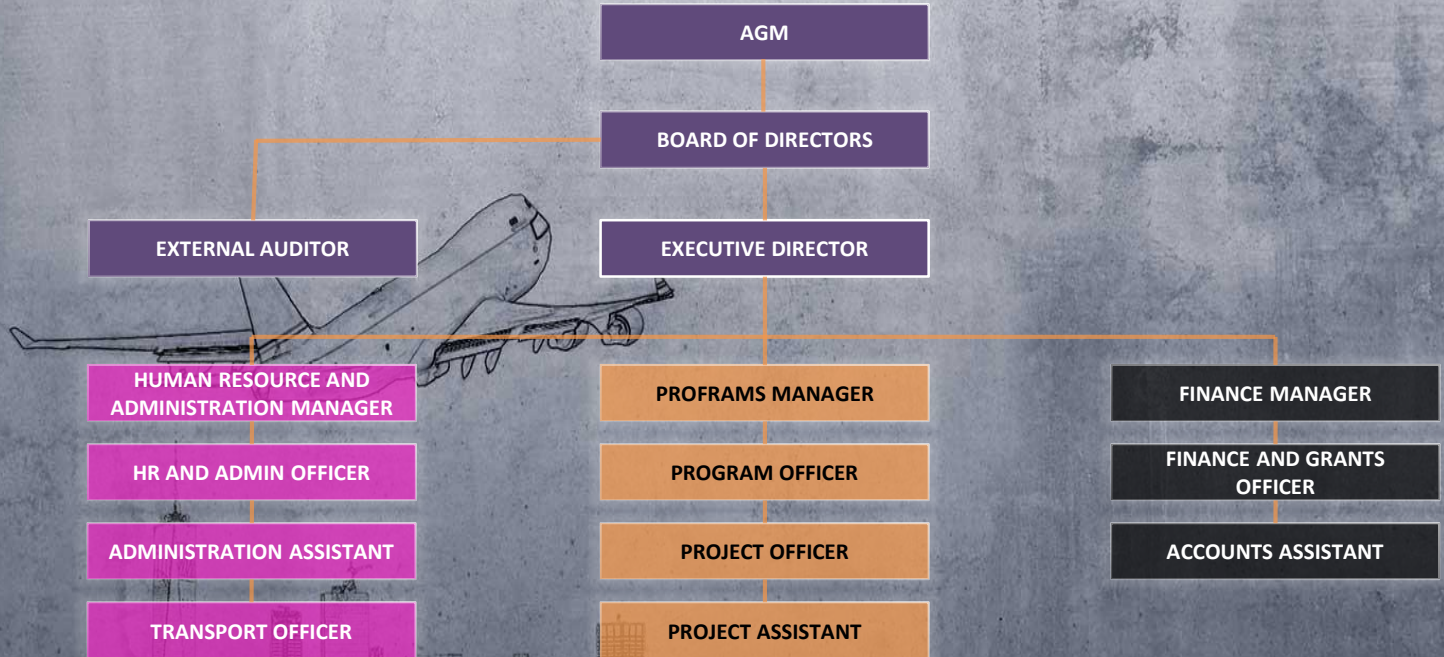


SPOTLIGHT

I was not knowledgeable about how and why it happens, and what to expect. So, naturally, I was scared and confused. I will never forget that experience,” Recalls a 16 year old Akurut, describing her first period. **My mother could not afford to buy pads for me so she taught me how to use cloth to manage the blood. One time, I stained my uniform at school and students laughed at me. I was very embarrassed. Since then I hated being in class during my periods.**

“Inspire youth came to our school and taught us about menstrual hygiene, career guidance, gender based violence and sexuality. I learnt to appreciate my body changes from the sessions. They also distributed to us reusable sanitary pads. I now go to school without fear of staining my uniform. I was selected as the chairperson of Inspire Health club in my school and our role is to educate the younger girls on menstrual hygiene and general cleanliness”.
