Weaver Creek Park Community Orchard and Gardens

The park is open to the public and boasts 500 fruit trees, 3 vineyards, 1 berry patch, Spider Woman Indigenous Plant Maze, a butterfly-shaped pollinator garden, a picnic pavilion, an apiary with around 20 beehives, and 70 community garden beds.

Day Groups for Individuals with Developmental Disabilities

In partnership with day habilitation services we provide enrichment programming, community, and teach valuable life skills including basic cooking skills, meal prep, gardening, irrigation, and bed building.

Butterfly and Bee Conservation

Beneficial insects are vital to thriving ecosystems. We work with national conservation experts to monitor populations and create habitats for vital pollinators and garden friends.

Native American Cultural Growing Practices and Decolonizing the American Diet

We work with Spirit of the Sun and Native American Elders to incorporate traditional growing practices, native plants, and cooking knowledge into our spaces and classes. Cultural events are listed on the calendar and open to the public.
