## A-The objectives of the Project

- Offer package of food to vulnerable children and women in North Kivu, Democratic Republic of the Congo, particularly those internally displaced by armed conflicts.
- Provide social assistance to vulnerable populations in North Kivu, thereby contributing to their health and well-being.
- Promote social welfare by helping refugee families to experience a moment of happiness

## B-Brief about the Country (socio-economic environment)

In the province of North Kivu in the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC), armed conflicts and volcanic eruptions have torn apart the social and economic fabric, causing massive displacement of populations. The once peaceful city of Goma has become a refuge for the displaced, but life there has become precarious, marked by fear, hunger, and misery.

Women, children, the elderly, and people living with disabilities are the most vulnerable, exposed to violence and insecurity. Displacement camps are overflowing with desperate families, facing inhumane living conditions, where malnutrition is rampant among the most vulnerable.

Alarming statistics from the International Organization for Migration (IOM) in October 2023 reveal an unprecedented humanitarian crisis, with hundreds of thousands of displaced people living in distressing conditions. War has left an indelible mark on the economy, creating a landscape of poverty, orphans, and beggars wandering the streets in search of aid.

The DRC is facing a multidimensional crisis that demands an urgent response. The suffering is palpable, but hope persists. It is imperative to act to alleviate distress, restore dignity, and build a future where peace and prosperity can finally flourish for all Congolese.

## C-Target group and beneficiaries

The project aims to assist 225 families facing food insecurity in Goma, Democratic Republic of the Congo. Each family will receive a food package containing 41.5 kg of provisions, valued at 40 \$ per family. Through the collaborative efforts of GLOBALGIVING and the VEFA FOUNDATION, these families will receive vital food assistance, demonstrating the organizations' commitment to the principles of solidarity and humanitarianism.
