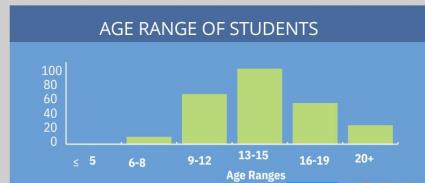
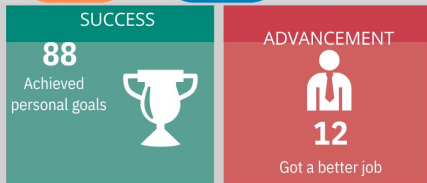
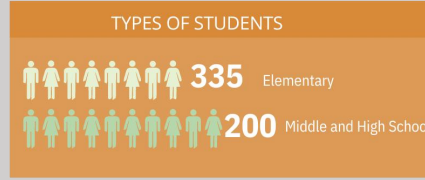
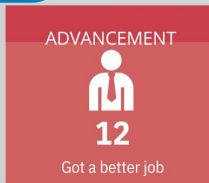


WITH SUPPORT FROM YOU... the lives of children and new mothers in rural areas in Africa are being changed

During the 2023 fiscal year, more than 535 children were enrolled in school and stayed in school, 54 new mothers learned skill work and 5 high school students got admission to universities in UK and US. Over 50 volunteers gave more than 23,000 hours. Most of them organize workshops to address the literacy challenges in children. Others serve on the Board or help run the organization's projects

What We Do

With our small staff and the generous support of others, we are making a meaningful impact in many rural areas in Africa by empowering the future generation and transforming the lives of teenage new parents. Thank you for helping us achieve our mission.

Our volunteers empower new mothers by teaching them essential literacy skills, enabling them to have a voice and make positive changes in their lives. The impact of these achievements extends beyond the individual to their families and communities. While we can measure tangible outcomes, such as improved skills and goal achievement, it's the increased self-confidence and self-worth that truly make a difference in our students' lives.

Our tutors "teach people to fish" by giving them stronger voices with improved literacy. When students gain new skills and achieve new goals, their lives change. The changes ripple outward to those in their households. And while we are able to report outcomes (see reverse side), what is more difficult to measure is increased self-confidence and self-worth. Our students say that makes all the difference.

How We Get it Done

Our dedicated team of 3 part-time staff members effectively manages and coordinates 535 students and make sure they enrolled in school. Despite working with limited resources, we maintain a positive and determined attitude to make a difference. Thanks to the generosity of our donors, we achieved a milestone in FY2023 by raising \$7,000 - the highest amount ever raised!

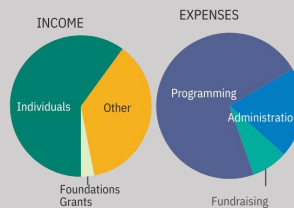
