**RE: REQUEST FOR CLARIFICATION AND FURTHER ADMINISTRATIVE ACTION  
ON PETITION DATED 16TH JUNE, 2025.**

I write in acknowledgment of your correspondence dated 3rd July, 2025 with reference number **OJS/P/11/V.1/2025** in response to my petition concerning procedural irregularities, judicial misconduct, and administrative dereliction in **Suit No. H1/22/2023** and related motions before the Court of Appeal, Kumasi.

While I appreciate the courtesy of your office in responding, I respectfully draw your attention to several critical issues that remain unaddressed and which are central to the fair and timely administration of justice:

**1. Functus Officio and Jurisdictional Irregularities**

The response did not address my primary contention that Justice Francis Obiri acted in excess of jurisdiction when, on 27th September 2021, he purported to set aside a valid High Court judgment (Suit No. C1/65/2020) despite:

- a) The pendency of an interlocutory appeal filed on 16th September 2021.
- b) The trial court being functus officio in respect of the matter.

I respectfully request clarification as to whether this jurisdictional irregularity was reviewed or subjected to any internal inquiry.

**2. Proof of Service Anomalies**

The Proof of Service dated 30th May 2025 issued by the Court of Appeal Registry records that the Notice of Appeal was filed on 27th September 2023 instead of 27th September 2021.

This is not a mere typographical error; it has materially delayed the progress of the appeal. No explanation or corrective action was addressed in your response.

### 3. Contradictory Judgment Dates

The certified copy of Justice Obiri’s ruling records the judgment date as **7th September 2021**, yet the Respondent’s motion referenced in that same ruling was filed on **8th September 2021**. This chronological inconsistency has not been explained and raises concerns regarding the authenticity and reliability of the certified court record.

### 4. Missing Written Submissions and Registry Mismanagement

My written submissions filed on 2nd February 2021—and later resubmitted digitally and physically—have not been properly incorporated into the appellate record. Your response did not clarify what steps have been taken to restore the missing records or to ensure that the appeal is set down for hearing without further delay.

### 5. Intimidation of Counsel and External Interference

The petition highlighted credible concerns about threats and intimidation of legal representatives, which appear to be affecting the impartiality of the appellate process. This issue was not addressed in your response.

## REQUEST FOR FURTHER ADMINISTRATIVE ACTION

In view of the above, I respectfully request that your office:

1. Provide **written clarification** on the five issues raised herein;
2. Confirm whether **any administrative inquiry or remedial steps** have been initiated;
3. Direct the **Registrar of the Court of Appeal** to restore all missing records and set the matter down for hearing as required by **Rule 20(3) of the Court of Appeal Rules, 1997 (C.I. 19)**.

I maintain my confidence in the Judiciary of Ghana and submit this follow-up in good faith, trusting that these matters will receive the urgent administrative attention they deserve to restore public confidence in the integrity of judicial proceedings.
