

Rehabilitation and Development of a Residential Care Facility for Orphaned Girls

Beirut, Lebanon

This proposal outlines a humanitarian rehabilitation project designed to provide safe housing, nutritious meals, supervised care, and educational support for orphaned girls in Beirut, Lebanon. The project focuses on rehabilitating an existing residential care facility into a stable, dignified, and child-friendly environment.

Executive Summary

This project will rehabilitate and equip a residential care facility designed to support orphaned girls through safe accommodation, educational support, daily meals, recreational space, and improved safety infrastructure. The project budget is estimated at \$150,000 with a projected implementation period of 10 months.

Humanitarian Context

Lebanon's prolonged economic crisis and instability have significantly impacted vulnerable children and placed increasing pressure on residential care institutions. Many orphaned girls continue to face housing insecurity, food instability, interrupted education, and limited access to safe support environments.

Project Objectives

The project aims to improve residential care conditions for orphaned girls by rehabilitating dormitory spaces, upgrading sanitation systems, improving safety infrastructure, creating educational and recreational areas, and strengthening long-term operational sustainability.

Facility Rehabilitation Scope

Planned rehabilitation includes dormitory upgrades, sanitation and plumbing systems, kitchen installation, electrical and heating improvements, security systems, recreational space development, and child-friendly interior rehabilitation.

Residential & Child Support Services

The facility will provide structured residential care, supervised accommodation, nutritious meals, educational support, psychosocial support, recreational activities, and safe child-centered living conditions designed to promote wellbeing and long-term stability.

Safety & Sustainability

The project includes fire safety systems, emergency infrastructure improvements, secure entrance systems, surveillance systems, and solar energy support to improve sustainability and reduce operational strain.

Expected Impact

The project will help improve long-term residential care capacity for orphaned girls in Beirut while strengthening humanitarian infrastructure and supporting safer, healthier, and more stable living conditions for vulnerable children.
