Project Title: Pathways to Integration: Supporting Refugees and Immigrant Families

Goal: To empower 500 refugee and immigrant families by providing essential services that facilitate their integration into their new communities and promote long-term self-sufficiency.

Budget Breakdown (\$200,000)

- **Basic Needs Support:** \$80,000
 - **Housing Assistance:** \$40,000
 - Temporary housing and rental support for families in need.
 - **Food and Clothing:** \$30,000
 - Emergency food supplies, clothing, and hygiene kits.
 - **Healthcare Access:** \$10,000
 - Assistance with medical expenses and access to health services.
- **Education and Employment:** \$70,000
 - **Job Training and Placement:** \$35,000
