Goal: \*\* To provide safe shelter and essential warmth to vulnerable families in Asyut, Egypt, by constructing or repairing roofs and supplying winter essentials like blankets and warm clothing.

### Budget Breakdown (\$100,000)

- \*\*Roof Construction and Repairs:\*\* \$50,000

- \*\*Building Materials and Labor:\*\* \$45,000

- Purchase of construction materials (wood, metal, insulation) and payment for skilled labor to construct or repair roofs.

- \*\*Project Management and Supervision:\*\* \$5,000

- Ensuring quality and timely completion of the construction work.

- \*\*Warm Clothing and Winter Supplies:\*\* \$35,000

- **Community Outreach and Awareness:** \$5,000

- **Outreach Programs:** \$3,000

- Initiatives to identify and support families in need, including local partnerships and awareness campaigns.

- **Educational Materials:** \$2,000

- Providing information on staying warm, safe, and healthy during the winter.
