It offers free health screenings and outreach programs that promote health education and advocacy. The program also provides medical assistance programs that offer access to free prescription drugs and medical equipment and supplies.</p>

Objectives & Rationale	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Provide accessible healthcare to residents of Chitral. • Establish a well-equipped First Aid Clinic within 9 months. • Improve health outcomes by offering emergency care and maternal health services.
Methodology	<p>The project will adopt a phased approach, starting with land acquisition, followed by construction and equipment setup, and finally, operationalization. Community engagement will ensure maximum utilization of the clinic's services. Progress will be monitored through monthly reports on construction, staffing, and equipment procurement. The clinic's operations will be evaluated based on the number of patients treated and community feedback.</p>
Likely Issues and Risk Analysis	<p>Harsh Weather: Extreme conditions, including heavy rainfall and snow, may delay construction and material delivery.</p> <p>Flooding: Seasonal flooding could damage construction sites and increase project costs.</p> <p>Road Blockages: Landslides and road closures due to snow or rain can hinder transportation and cause delays.</p>

	Snowfall: Heavy snow in winter may require temporary halts in construction, extending the project timeline.
Community Participation	Community Participation is very important for the successful completion of any project. Local dignitaries will be engaged throughout the project
Monitoring and Evaluation	Alkhidmat Foundation Pakistan will be responsible for overall project implementation which includes Planning, Transportation. This whole process will be documented, supervised, and executed by Program Manager (Health) Each activity of the project will be monitored closely to ensure efficiency and transparency. After thorough Monitoring and Evaluation, Project status will be communicated to the donor as per the decided Reporting schedule.
