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## HOW YOUR SUPPORT CREATES CHANGE

- ✓ **Expanded reach:** Enrolment for After-school programme grew 56% above initial target, driven by community trust and word-of-mouth referrals.
- ✓ **Stronger families:** Parental and Child Protection meetings moved to monthly, improving caregiver involvement in children's education and protection.
- ✓ **Child protection:** Home visits, family assessments, and Child Protection engagement strengthened safeguarding for the most vulnerable cases.
- ✓ **Richer programming:** Sessions evolved from academic support alone to include mentorship, life skills, recreation, and psychosocial support.
- ✓ **Emotional wellbeing:** 102 counselling sessions delivered improved school adjustment, participation, and emotional resilience among children.
- ✓ **Community ownership:** The April Fun Day drew 106 children and 52+ adults - a public demonstration of the programme's deep local roots.
