Project

Summary

The Gaza Strip, devastated by war, faces a severe humanitarian crisis that has left university students among the hardest hit.

Over 80% of schools have been destroyed, 88,000 students have been forced to halt their studies, and 555 scholarship recipients are stranded abroad. Displaced students live in makeshift shelters without access to internet, electricity, or proper study spaces, while families rely entirely on aid due to the loss of income. Most students cannot afford the \$10 daily cost for basic study necessities, putting their education on hold indefinitely.

In response, the Gaza Education Hub provides free spaces equipped with internet, electricity, and essential resources to create a supportive learning environment for displaced students. By offering this lifeline, the initiative empowers Gaza's youth to continue their academic journey and build a brighter future. Together, we can rebuild education and hope for the students of Gaza.

- Provide a safe, conducive learning environment for **1000+ displaced students to continue their education online**
- Supply essential resources like **internet, electricity, and study materials**
- Support the **educational recovery, academic performance and mental resilience** of students in Gaza
- Promote **socio-economic development** in Gaza

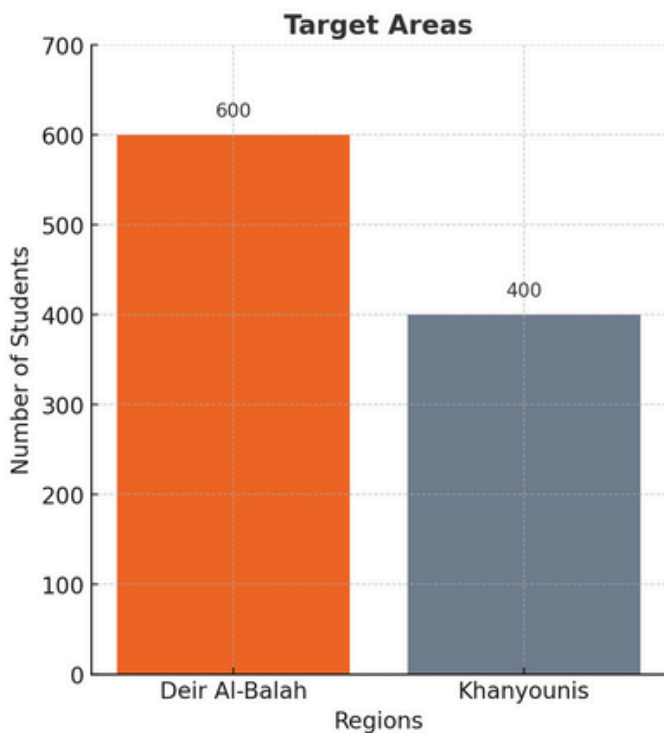

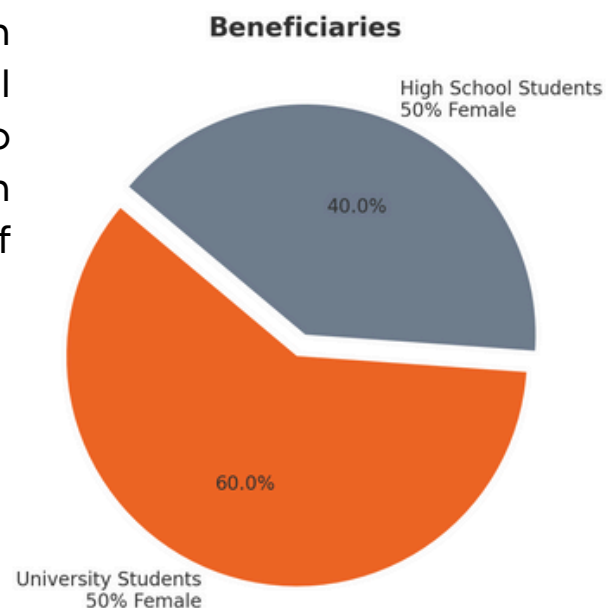

We have piloted our work in Deir El Balah – South Gaza (phase I), and are working to fully launch the hub here to serve a community of 600 students as part of phase II and III goals.

Future plans include opening new hubs in Khanyounis and Northern Gaza to replicate the success of our model and scale our impact to reach 1000+ students.

During our pilot, we served both university and high school students, and will continue to provide services for both, of which female students represent half of the community.



2024

Impact

Phase I: Pilot Launch and Initial Operations

- Secured \$560 in funding from an initial single donor.
- Renewed the funding from the same donor two more times over three months, reaching a total of \$1,620.
- Launched the pilot space on 31 August 2024, serving as a hub for educational activities.
- Supported 120 students, providing consistent access to educational resources. Each student attended two-hour sessions per day, three days a week.
- Delivered 8,640 study hours across all students.
- Maintained 540 operational hours of the space to facilitate learning and engagement.

Phase II: Expansion and Capacity Building

- Developed a crowdfunding campaign in partnership with BuildPalestine and Impact Hub Amman, successfully reaching the 15,000 Euros target.
- Secured the full, winter-friendly space in November 2024.
- Installed the minimum number of solar panels to power operations.
- Opened doors of the new space to an additional number of 250 students.

Phase III: Sustainable Growth and Future Planning

- Extended fundraising efforts with VCS Academy CIC, setting a new target of 46,438\$.
- Set a target to reach 600 students in this phase.

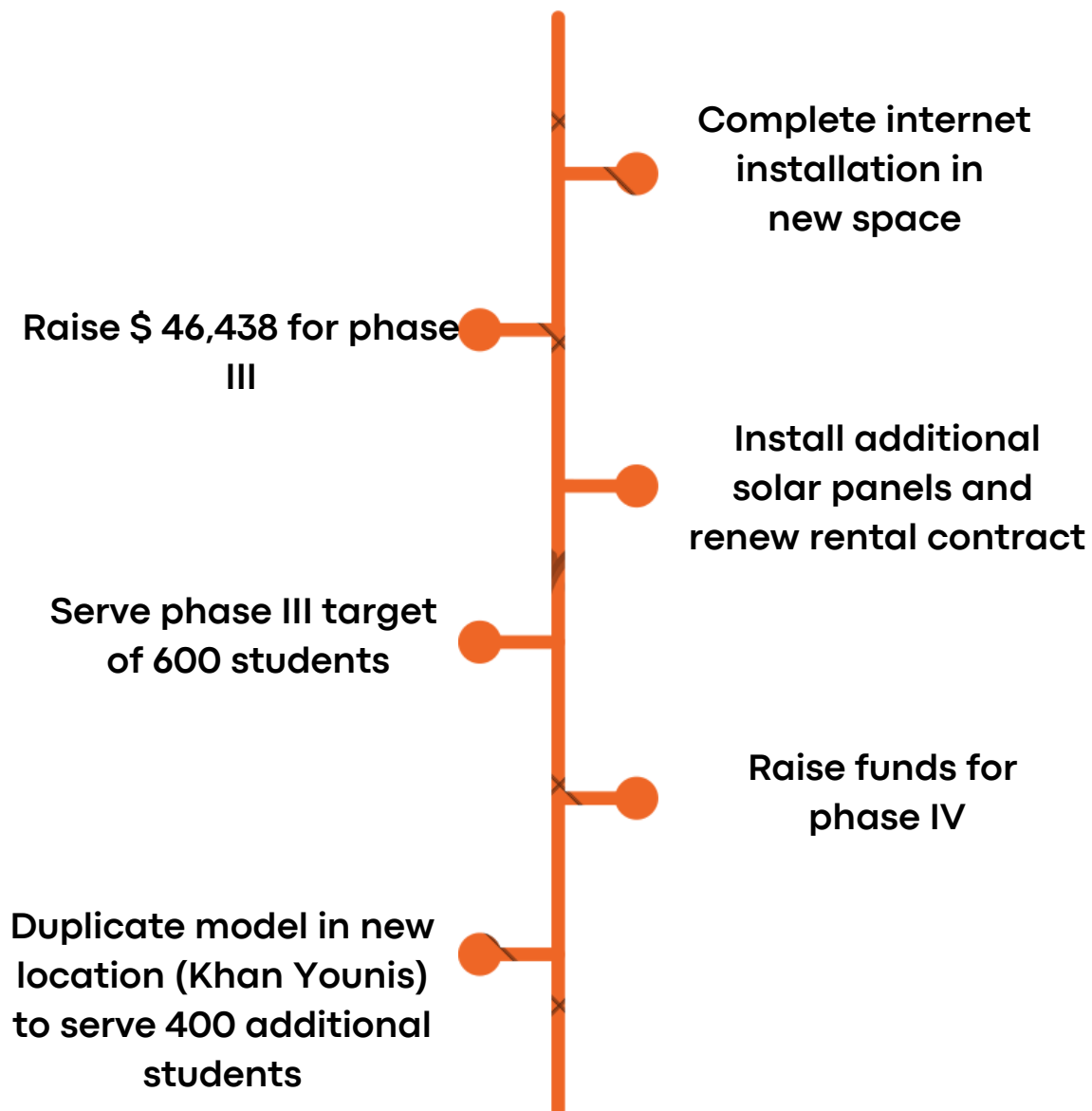
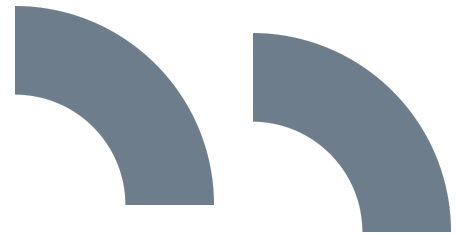

- **Resource Mobilisation:** Partnering with NGOs, businesses, and donors to secure funding and resources.
