We are THE ANDTEX TRAINING AND CARE ORGANISATION (TATCO Uganda) a Community Based Organisation which was formed in 2010 as community youth group and later fully registered to operate as a CBO in 2013. We are currently carrying out our work in the in the central rural villages in the districts of Mukono, Buikwe and Wakiso in Uganda having our Headquarter in Bukerere- Goma Division in Mukono District. The organisation's main activities are tailored at promoting quality and affordable **Education** to vulnerable community children, **Early Child Development programs, Vocational Training programs for the Youths, Livelihood/ Economic Empowerment to the Women, Human Rights awareness and advocacy, and Care and support to the elderly and sick community persons, Environment and Climate Change.**

#### 2. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

As an Organisation, it is our desire and has seen a necessity to bring updated and educative information written in books and online using computers connected to the internet to our community children and youths in Bukerere community Bukerere, Goma Division at large.

We have therefore identified the establishment of a Community library and computer laboratory targeting both pupils in the school and non formal school children and youths in Bukerere as an alternative option to this extension service.

#### **3. PROJECT JUSTIFICATION**

#### **Current situation**

Bukerere is in a rural setup, east of Kampala with over 9 villages and an ever increasing number of children.

The area has a few schools but none of them is equipped with facilities needed in teaching and training learners in an advanced and modern way today which still keep them lag behind in academics, poor performance on the national level exams compared to those in town and in well facilitated schools. The world is advancing technologically and we are in the 21<sup>st</sup> century which is an Information zone, this said is not yet possible in our Bukerere Rural community, children still acquire education in the old way which is caused by lack of access to written and illustrated literature, story books, digital research equipments and skills. This also in another way negatively affects the Youths and other community members in their bid to economic growth.

Because of this, TATCO Uganda has a plan to setup up a fully equipped and functioning center in Bukerere with a Book Library stocked with both academic and economics books, computer lab which will benefit the school going Children, Teachers and Youths in the community who will have a chance to learn, use and connect internationally in a digital way which will easy information flow and sharing among the beneficiaries.

#### 4. OUR INTENT

With the advancement of digital age and technological know-how, there is a necessity to keep people up to date progress in the world of information and integrating ICT in learning of the pupils, hence the need for community library and computer lab centre. The children and youth residing within our area of jurisdiction still languish in abject poverty. This has been attributed greatly to lack of information, lack of skills to execute a gainful venture, youth idleness and environmental pollution. It is our interest that the idea of a increasing the reading culture and information sharing with easy access to a library and computer lab will act as a catalyst to many of these challenges. The youth will learn on many important and viable projects that would see them generate income for themselves. Furthermore, as the saying goes, "there is power in knowledge". The people will be developed intellectually hence can make informed decisions.

#### 5. PROJECT OBJECTIVES

- To promote a culture of reading among the school going children and other youths in the community.
- To equip children with extra information from the class. (Outside class tutoring)
- To improve literacy among the children in the community.
- To bring updated and educational information close to the people who might not under ordinary circumstances access such information.
- To improve children' performance in class and out of school in the community with free access to written literature.
- To align well with the new primary schools academic curriculum in Uganda that emphasizes practical teaching.
- To deliver learners with a learning experience in instructional technology.
- To provide opportunities for exchange of knowledge, innovation, digital entrepreneurship, social values and expertise through sharing of online resources by the pupils and other community members.
- To provide children and youths with computer skills which can at the end after school help them in the community for job creation and business management
- To make our pupils ready and able to compete with other learners in urban and developed schools in and outside Uganda.

#### 6. EXPECTED OUTCOMES

Some of the results to the indicators will be:

- The culture of reading among the pupils and other people in the community will be promoted.
- Pupils, teachers, and other community youths will be able to obtained updated information for their growth in knowledge.
- Enhancing traditional teaching through the use of ICT in excellence schools
- Facilitating blended learning within and across subject areas
- Creating and managing ever-present and interactive e-learning environments
- Beneficiaries will be empowered with relevant basic ICT skills to effectively compete in the academic and social world.

## **10.METHODOLOGY OF WORK**

- Project location is at one of our community centers where the intended beneficiaries i.e the pupils and the youth are centralized and the home of our organization headquarters.
- The project will be managed by the Progressive Volunteers, TATCO education staff and teachers in support of qualified librarian and computer skills supervising the daily progress.
- Digital library with internet-connected computers for children and youth researchers.
- Library centre will be publicized adequately: sizable banners on strategic positions, posters, and announcements made in centers of worship e.g. church and mosques, local radio stations.
- Continued request for support from telecom companies in Uganda to provide free internet connections.
- TATCO's ability to pay for utility i.e electricity over time.

### **11. SUSTAINABILITY**

- TATCO Uganda and the Library administrators will ensure the proper maintenance of records (appropriate users registration, exit and return date of the books, recovery methodology).
- Full time librarian will be placed in the library and computer lab to ensure good care of the books and computers to oversee the orderly running of the facility.
- Quarterly meetings with the library administrators, youth leadership committee and other community leaders to check on the libraries' status.
- Minimal registration and evaluation fee to be charged on some of the professional researchers and internet users who are not part of the intended vulnerable local beneficiaries to ensure daily maintenance and project sustainability.

#### **12. MONITORING AND EVALUATION**

The whole program will be under the supervision of a monitoring team and supported by documentation. The monitoring team will be appointed either by the funding agency or by our organization. The monitoring team will be selected so as to ensure community participation. There will be a Programs Manager to monitor the entire program and document the activities. An annual audit and evaluation will be in place for the budget and will have comments and the action through the budget.
