**Materials:** 272 skeins of yarn, 22 scissors

**Participants:** 68

**Investment:** \$3578

**Place:** Rodeopamba Community, Guaranda, Ecuador.

**W**e teach how to knit hats and scarves, using an ancestral indigenous technique that only requires the use of the fingers.





# KNIT AND SEED

**Materials:** 36 skeins of yarn, 10 crochet hooks, 5 scissors, liquid silicone, solid silicone.

**Participantes:** 9

**Inversión:** \$ 938

**Lugar:** Historical Center, Quito, Ecuador.

We teach how to knit flowers, cup holders, bags using different types of stitches: chain stitch, running stitch, single crochet, half double crochet, double crochet, magic ring.
