2. Project Synopsis

F Ssibu Mission Foundation Uganda is a non-governmental, non-profit community-based organization dedicated to empowering vulnerable youth through education and skills training. This proposal seeks funding to establish a vocational training school in Mukono -Mwanyagiri to support dropout girls and boys. The school will provide practical skills in areas such as computer literacy, tailoring, carpentry, and agriculture, enabling students to gain employable skills and reintegrate into society

as productive citizens. With a total budget of USD 28050, the project will include a computer lab, sanitation facilities, classrooms, and basic workshop spaces.

3. Background and Context

In Uganda, many youths, especially girls and boys from low-income families, drop out of school due to poverty, early pregnancies, child labor, and lack of accessible education. Without skills or qualifications, they face limited opportunities, perpetuating cycles of poverty and vulnerability. Vocational training offers a practical pathway to self-reliance, employment, and community development. F Ssibu Mission Foundation aims to address this gap by establishing a vocational school that provides free or low-cost training to dropout youth in Mukono and beyond.

4. Project Description

4.1 Goals

To equip dropout girls and boys with market-relevant vocational skills, fostering economic independence and social reintegration.

4.2 Objectives

- Provide free vocational training to at least 50 dropout youths annually.
- Reduce youth unemployment and idleness in Mukono and beyond.
- Promote gender equality by ensuring equal participation of girls and boys.
- Enhance digital literacy through computer-based training.
- Improve sanitation and learning environments with proper facilities.

4.3 Target Beneficiaries

- Dropout girls and boys aged 11–18 from Mukono-mwanyagiri village and surrounding areas.
- Youth from low-income, orphaned, or otherwise vulnerable backgrounds.

- Classrooms/Training Spaces: 3 multi-purpose rooms
- Computer Lab: 10 computers cost: 2030 USD
- Toilet Facility: 4-stance toilet block estimated cost: 2050 USD
- Workshop Areas: For tailoring, carpentry, and agriculture
- Office/Administration Room: 1
- Furniture and Learning Materials: Desks, chairs, tools, and training kits
- Water Source: Rainwater harvesting system
