This will encourage other less active communities to ‘pick up the pace’, realizing it is not so difficult to live sustainably while not only helping the environment, but enjoying contributing to its health and our own.

- **Project Interest:** There has been extraordinary interest by young professionals and graduate students to be a part of Adventure4ever's dynamic Team. Word of mouth and what people are now starting to notice online is creating that interest, to the extent that we get calls and emails weekly, sometimes daily, commenting on how important this project is and asking how they can be a part of it. They are very willing to volunteer to help us reach our goal with this project and the documentary film series '**Full Circle**'.

Results: Just under a month ago we brought on two very talented new members to our Team, to assist with our social media and fundraising efforts. They have worked together previously. Another example of word of mouth and its effectiveness. This is a huge plus for the team, as our project grows bigger and bigger every week, every day. We want to welcome Engin Tashkaya and Sedef Korkmaz to the Team. Recently I was introduced to a young graduate who had heard about the project. Adding to this, a young biologist, specializing in sustainability, will be of great benefit in interacting with universities/colleges/and other academic institutions plus providing a wealth of scientific knowledge to our team and be of benefit in giving workshops while on the road.



Upcoming Plans & Priorities

- The advance scouting/press trips we are doing will continue through 2025 into 2026 across Europe and into Turkiye. These advance trips focus on preparing our team for the selection of locations for the actual filming and getting to know the local communities in all countries. These advance trips are also very much for the communities as we offer a wide range of workshops while in their country on community development, public speaking, and much more, giving the opportunity for selected communities to present their initiatives and actions toward greater sustainability in their region. We also encourage the locals to start with new programs and initiatives, bring together new local members and discuss how they can go even further to demonstrate their own growth in the time period between the advance trip and the actual filming. This brings us all together with hope and enthusiasm to reach the same goal through this project; a greener, more balanced environment with clear directives for a well thought out action plan to help our planet.
- During the next 6-12 months we will host webinars, with members of our own team but also special guests we have met during our advance trips (locals and community leaders, plus Tourism representatives) who will speak about their work and HOW they have managed to bring green initiatives into practice, projects to rebuild our eco-system and biodiversity, plus so much more.
- Alongside this we plan to start a monthly newsletter to be distributed to our now growing mailing list.
- Continued work with GlobalGiving to boost our fundraising campaign with their tremendous assistance and cooperation.
