# Introduction to Alkhidmat Foundation

Alkhidmat Foundation Pakistan is one of the country's leading non-profit organizations, dedicated to humanitarian services since its inception. Guided by principles of compassion and integrity, Alkhidmat Foundation operates across various sectors, including education, health, disaster management, community service, Islamic Microfinance WASH and orphan care. With a nationwide volunteer, the organization strives to uplift underserved communities and contribute towards a more equitable society. Our Education Department, in particular, focuses on providing quality educational opportunities for children who are out of school, homeless, or living in poverty, ensuring they have the support and resources needed to succeed.

## Executive Summary

This report presents the successful completion of the Renovation of Child Protection Centers (CPCs) in South Punjab project. Funded by donations raised on GlobalGiving, this initiative aimed to upgrade CPCs in Vihari, Multan, and Rahim Yar Khan. Through this project, Alkhidmat Foundation has provided these centers with much-needed facilities and resources, creating a safe and encouraging environment that promotes learning and personal growth for vulnerable children.

## Project Background and Rationale

Pakistan faces a severe educational crisis, with an estimated 26.2 million children out of school, the second-highest number globally. This situation is exacerbated by poverty, social inequities, and a lack of accessible educational infrastructure. As a result, countless children are left vulnerable to exploitation, malnutrition, and lack of basic literacy and skills.

To address these challenges, Alkhidmat Foundation established 66 Child Protection Centers (CPCs) across Pakistan. CPCs offer street children and other vulnerable youth a safe space to learn, grow, and develop critical life skills. These centers play an essential role in protecting at-risk children by providing them with education, emotional support, and a structured environment that fosters personal development. The CPCs are indispensable in Pakistan's effort to combat child labor, poverty, and educational exclusion, helping children transition into mainstream education and, ultimately, a better future.

## Project Objectives

The primary objectives of the renovation project were:

- Renovation and Upgradation of Three CPCs in South Punjab to create a safer and more positive learning environment.
- Provision of 150 Chairs for Student Use across the three centers to improve classroom comfort and participation.
- Distribution of Essential Educational Supplies, including school bags and stationery, to enable children to participate actively in learning activities.

# Project Implementation Process

This renovation project was spearheaded by Alkhidmat Foundation's Education Department, with generous funding sourced through GlobalGiving. The following key activities were undertaken:

**Physical Renovation:** The CPCs in Vihari, Multan, and Rahim Yar Khan underwent a comprehensive refurbishment process, which included repainting, necessary structural repairs, and optimization of the classroom layouts to enhance functionality.

**Furniture Installation:** 150 new chairs were procured and installed, providing comfortable seating for students and contributing to a conducive learning atmosphere.

**Provision of Learning Materials:** School bags and stationery kits were distributed to all enrolled children, ensuring they have the basic tools required to engage actively in educational activities.

# Why Child Protection Centers are Essential in Pakistan

With Pakistan's substantial out-of-school population, Child Protection Centers offer a critical intervention for children otherwise overlooked by the formal education system. These centers provide a beacon of hope for street children, safeguarding them from the risks associated with street life, including exploitation, abuse, and neglect. Beyond basic education, CPCs offer emotional support, mentoring, and guidance. By equipping children with literacy, numeracy, and life skills, CPCs foster resilience and open pathways to reintegration into formal education, empowering these young individuals to build a brighter future.

# Outcomes and Impact

**Improved Educational Environment:** Renovated classrooms now provide a clean, well-organized space that enhances the learning experience, facilitating focus and engagement.

**Enhanced Student Comfort and Participation:** New seating has improved classroom comfort, encouraging children to actively participate in learning activities.

**Increased Motivation through Supplies Provision:** The distribution of school bags and stationery has had a positive psychological impact, as children feel equipped and encouraged to attend regularly and engage more confidently in their studies.

# Community Impact and Long-term Benefits

The renovation of these CPCs has had a positive ripple effect within the local communities in South Punjab. By offering marginalized children a dignified and supportive educational setting, the project reinforces the Alkhidmat Foundation's mission of empowering underserved communities through education. The upgraded CPCs serve as a safe place for these children, providing continuity in their education and helping to break the cycle of poverty that has long affected these communities. These centers are now better positioned to make a lasting difference in the lives of the children they serve.




## Sustainable Development Goals

# Recommendations for Expanding Child Protection Centers (CPCs) Across Pakistan

**Regional Needs Assessment** Conduct a detailed needs assessment in targeted areas, focusing on regions with high out-of-school populations, child labor, and social vulnerabilities. Prioritize areas based on data from local government agencies and community stakeholders to identify regions most in need of CPCs.

**Leverage Global Platforms:** Strengthen partnerships with international platforms like GlobalGiving and UN agencies to secure funding.

**Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR):** Engage with local and multinational corporations operating in Pakistan, inviting them to support CPC expansions through CSR initiatives.

**Individual Donors:** Develop targeted campaigns to attract individual donors locally and internationally, emphasizing the positive impact of CPCs.

**Strengthen Partnerships with Local NGOs and Government** For partnerships with local NGOs and government agencies to facilitate resource sharing, referrals, and outreach. Coordination with government bodies can also help in identifying potential sites and receiving logistical support.

**Regular Impact Assessments** Schedule regular impact assessments to measure outcomes, such as school enrollment rates, reduction in child labor, and improvements in literacy and numeracy. These assessments will help in refining strategies and demonstrating the CPCs' impact to attract additional funding
