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Message from the executive director to our community

In December 2023, I was proud to learn that one of our Champs had been admitted to one of the best universities in the world. A few days later, when I met with the Champ's mother, she marked me with a phrase: **"Peru Champs gave us the opportunity to dream."** She told me how our organization had transformed not only her son's life but also her family's. And that is what we do: **we transform lives through education.**

At Peru Champs, **we aim to ensure that no exceptional talent is left without the opportunity to change our world.** To this end, we train children and adolescents to become future leaders committed to the common good and responsible for their actions, empathetic and compassionate leaders committed to pursuing justice.

Thanks to the support of our community, **we achieved the proposed objectives.** Thus, we reached our fundraising goal thanks to **local (33%) and international (67%) donors.** In addition, we had the **support of 10 companies and 335 employees** who joined our corporate volunteer program, helping us train our Champs in different skills that would allow them to develop their leadership abilities. Finally, this year, we continued with **strategic alliances** such as Hush Puppies (Walking to school together), Plaza Vea, Vivanda, Oechsle, Promart, and Inkafarma (spare change), among many others.

In addition, we had 5300 applications, of which **650 kids passed all the processes and were awarded the scholarship.** Likewise, **we implemented tailored curriculum** focused on the individual development of each Champ and integrated it into our different areas, with the objective of visualizing in an integral way which were the programs in a holistic each one participated and which were the ones they should include **to continue strengthening their profile as leaders of our society.**

Additionally, the area of **Selection and Follow-up** developed a **strategic** plan to cover the increase of vulnerability cases in 2023, managing to treat each Champ in the right way, accompanying their socio-emotional education hand in hand with their families through our various **workshops and sessions**.

In addition, **continuing with the development not only of academic but also artistic and sports talents**, we strengthened our alliances with outstanding sports organizations (Universitario de Deportes, Alianza Lima, Sporting Cristal, Sport Boys, Academia Deportiva Cantolao, UCV, Manucci, FPG and its golf project in San Bartolo, among others) and artistic organizations (Sinfonía por el Perú).

In 2024, we will continue to work hard to achieve our purpose, that no exceptional talent is left without the possibility of changing our world.

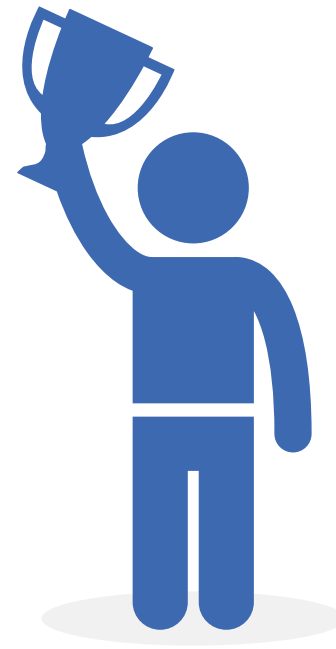

Who is a **Champ**

Is a **low-income child in school** with extraordinary academic, artistic or athletic talent. Likewise, he/she has **great leadership potential**, with values, to generate innovative and **sustainable projects in Peru**.

What does a Champ receive?

- **75% tuition scholarship** for Innova Schools (registration + monthly tuition).
- **Leadership program** to develop their skills.
- **Psychological support** to take care of their mental health.
- **Interdisciplinary workshops** for parents.
- **School supplies** at the beginning of each year.

How to become a Champ?

The selection process to achieve the educational scholarship consists of a massive national call for applications, in which the applicants are evaluated in different skills. All this process is possible thanks to the cooperation of state institutions, organizations and private companies.

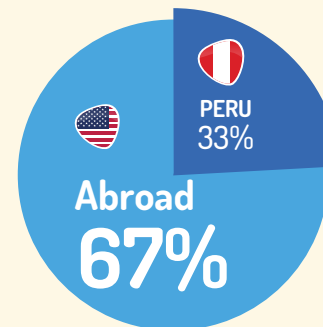

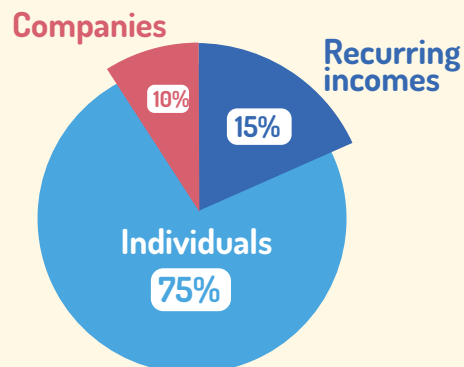

Recurring income channels



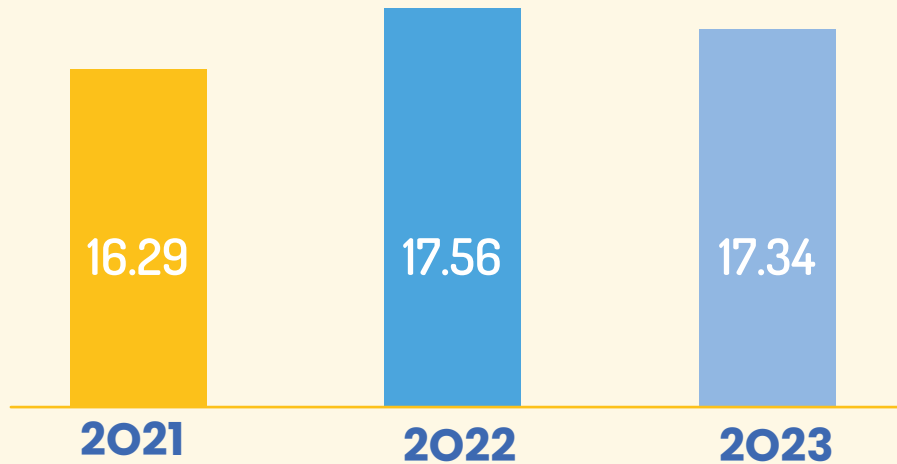

Despite the pandemic, the economic and political crisis in the country during the last few years, 2023 remained relatively stable, which positively influenced the Champs' grade performance.

In Peru, the grading system goes from 0 to 20, being 11 an approval grade.

Female power Champs

Zoe is a 10-year-old Champ with a passion for sports who excels as a Sporting Cristal soccer team member. Upon joining, she had to face challenges at a young age, such as competing against older girls or facing stereotypes that limited her participation in soccer. However, **with the support of her family and friends, she became an outstanding athlete.**

Since the beginning of this year, Zoe has been part of the Peru Champs and Innova Schools family, experiencing a positive impact on her life. Today, **she persists in her dream of becoming a professional soccer player**, traveling due to her sporting talents, and joining prestigious clubs such as Barcelona or Real Madrid.

Zoe thanks the Leadership Program for giving her the tools and support to become a leader of tomorrow. **She is a source of inspiration that encourages other girls to follow their dreams**, reminding them that nothing and no one can stop them when they follow their passion. **Her story proves that girls can achieve their aspirations with hard work and support.**



English leveling

The English leveling project sought to facilitate the pedagogical adaptation to improve the English level of the incoming Champs.

For this purpose, the Duolingo for Schools program was used, a self-learning platform applied virtually from January to February 2023. **The proposed objective was for students to practice a total of 40 effective hours of English.**

The program is aimed at new Champs, who do not know yet the emphasis we put on commitment. Those that accepted to participate, but did not finish the required hours, get a warning (unless they have a valid justification).

Selection and follow-up

We have specialists in clinical, educational and social psychology, who design and implement various interventions to families and Champs individually or in groups. In 2023 we worked under the latest generation approach that contains contextual therapies, which have scientific evidence and are effective in less time.

Follow-up areas

- 1 Adaptation**
Accompaniment in the adaptation process of incoming Champs in the **psychological, social and academic areas**.
- 2 Follow-up**
Follow-up of the Champs at headquarters to **identify risk cases and success stories** in Lima and the regions.
- 3 Update**
Update of the **pre and post entrance evaluation of the Champs** to the Peru Champs Scholarship Program (mapping).
- 4 Communication**
Constant communication between the Peru Champs team, Innova Schools and the Champs families.
- 5 Accompaniment**
Various workshops and programs to **strengthen family ties and empower families to generate a positive impact** on the formation of the Champs.

We seek to strengthen socioemotional **education in families and reinforce the protective factors that can influence the development of our Champs**.
- 6 Psychoeducation**
Our Champs are internally classified according to the degree of vulnerability or risk that our team determines (**high, medium and low**). Thus, based on these levels, the interventions and their frequencies vary.

Renewal

Peru Champs scholarships **are automatically renewed on an annual basis**, without having to take another exam if the following requirements are met:

Champs

- Minimum grade point **average of 15 (academic talent), 13 (athletic or artistic talent) or A (elementary)**.
- **Comply with the internal rules** of Innova Schools (e.g. good conduct, punctuality).

Family

- Comply with the **payment of monthly tuition** (25% of the total) that corresponds to the families.
- Attend at least **4 parent meetings** per year (in person or virtually).
- Continue with **economic need**.

During the year 2023, emotional support was provided to Champs at **medium and high risk in order to ensure their renewal at year-end**. In addition, 3107 interventions were provided to the Champs.

Projects for families



Families SOS

- **Objective:** Establish direct contact with families through a **brigadier at each Innova Schools site**. In this way, this person helps the psychology team to **identify at-risk cases or families with difficulties and communicate quickly with our community**.
- Currently, **all sites** have one or two **brigadiers** according to the number of Champs families.
- **Achievements:** **51 parents and/or mothers of Champs brigadiers** received 2 training workshops on psychological first aid and helped us to maintain more effective communication with families.



Conscious families workshop

- **Objective:** To work on the basis of parenting and, in this way, help them **assimilate new information about what parenting implies and the wounds they have from their own childhood**.
- Through **4 workshops a year**, emotional tools are provided to Champs' families so that they can **create a healthy bond with their children respecting the different realities**.
- **Achievements:** **86% of Champs families were impacted** and 91% satisfaction was obtained.



Financial empowerment

- **Objective:** Promote **spaces of interest, knowledge and application of financial education** in the finances of Champs families.
- **2 annual workshops** for Champs families.
- **Achievements:** Participation of **713 Champs families**, achieving 87% satisfaction with the workshops.



Healthy Families

- **Objective:** Promote **spaces for active participation and strengthen capacities on issues related to food security** for the families of Peru Champs.
- **2 annual workshops** for Champs families.
- **Achievements:** **576 Champs families participated**, achieving a 90% satisfaction rate with the workshops.



Workshops for entrepreneurial families

- **Objective:** **Strengthen the capacities and skills of Champs families through innovative strategies** to improve and enhance their enterprises or business ideas.
- **2 annual workshops** aimed at Champs families who wish to start or have businesses.
- **Achievements:** **106 Champs families participated**, achieving 92% satisfaction with the workshops provided.

Leadership Program

The **Leadership Program** seeks to train Champs as future leaders with values. For this purpose, it has the Leadership Program where capacities and skills are enhanced in different projects aligned with the **Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs)**.

Achievements

- Participation of **89% Champs in the various leadership training programs**, and obtained an **improvement of 18% in learnings**.
- Thanks to virtual volunteering, we were able to impact Champs in Arequipa, Ancash, Cusco, Huánuco, Ica, Junín, Lima, La Libertad, Lambayeque, Moquegua, Piura, Puno, San Martín, Tacna and Ucayali. Volunteers from various parts of the world also participated.

The consulting area, recently created, **seeks to contribute to the social and sustainable development of external companies and organizations according to their interests and objectives** in order to establish strategic alliances where an impact is obtained for their target public or Champs. 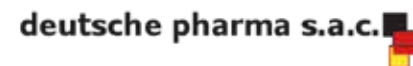
