Although we have not yet reached the \$40,000 target, the \$4,633 raised so far has helped us make things happen. With your support, we managed to cover the following:

- Documentation for Marry, her kidney donor, and caretaker (her father).
- Passports, visas, and air tickets for their travel to India.
- Basic initial medical costs upon arrival.

On 21st June 2025, Marry, her donor, and her father traveled safely to India. Initially, we estimated their stay to last three months. However, due to the extensive medical procedures and evaluations required for both the donor and receiver, the process has taken longer than expected.





At this stage, Mary's kidney transplant has not yet been approved, as doctors continue to carry out thorough medical tests and clearances to ensure the procedure's safety and success.

Despite the financial gap, we have not stopped supporting Mary and her family. Every step forward has been possible because of your kindness. We remain hopeful and committed to raising the remaining funds needed to cover:

- Hospital and surgical expenses.
- Post-surgery treatment and medications.
- Extended living costs during their stay in India.
