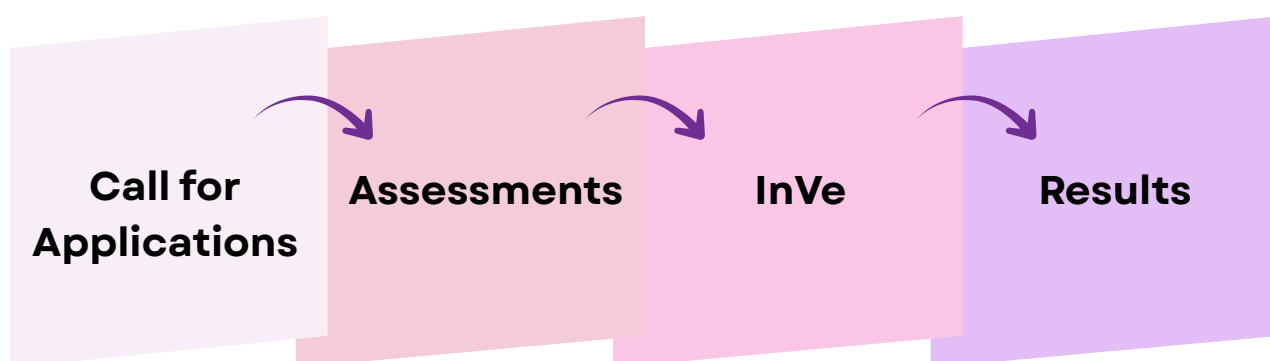

# General Overview

Between May and September 2025, Enseña Ecuador carried out key actions to strengthen educational leadership through the **Lead to Transform (LET) program**.

Two milestones marked this period:

1. Recruitment and selection of the LET 2025–2026 cohort.
2. Implementation of the Summer Institute (InVe).

178 Completed Phase 2

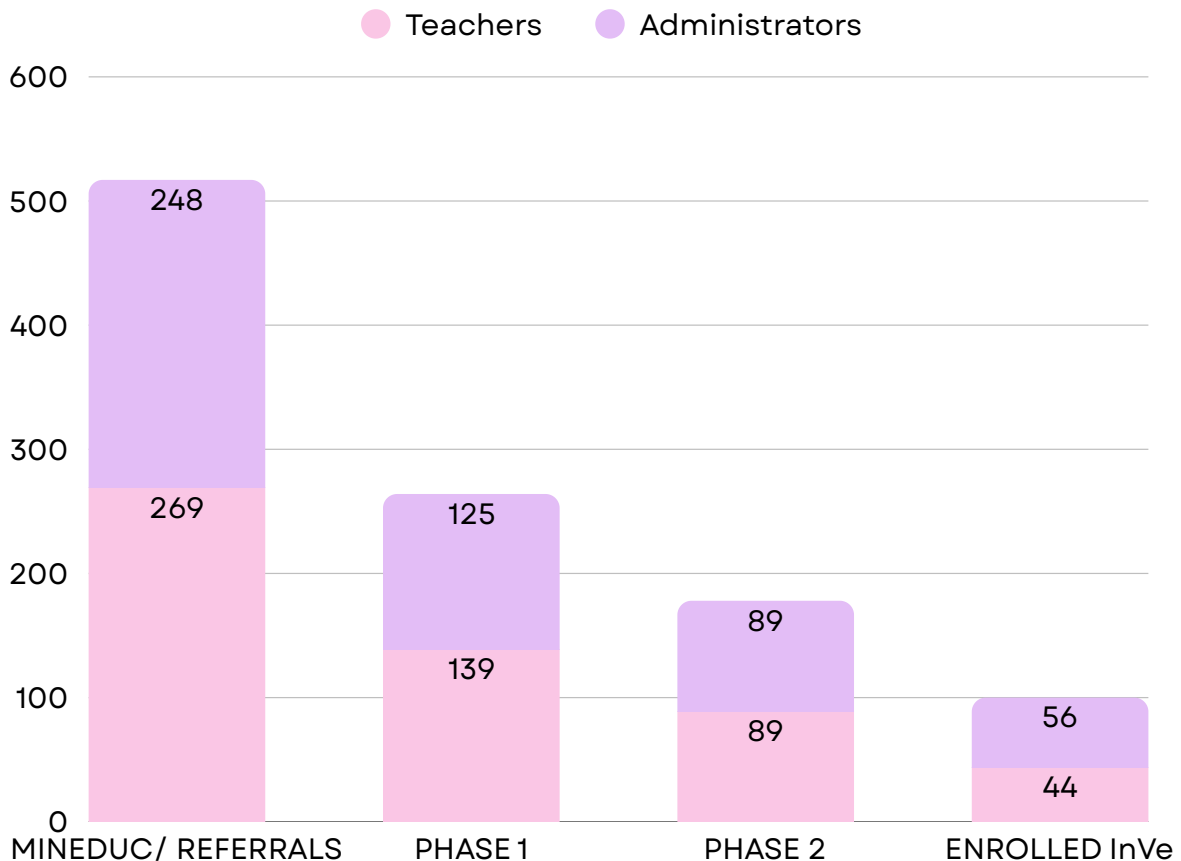


100 Enrolled in InVe

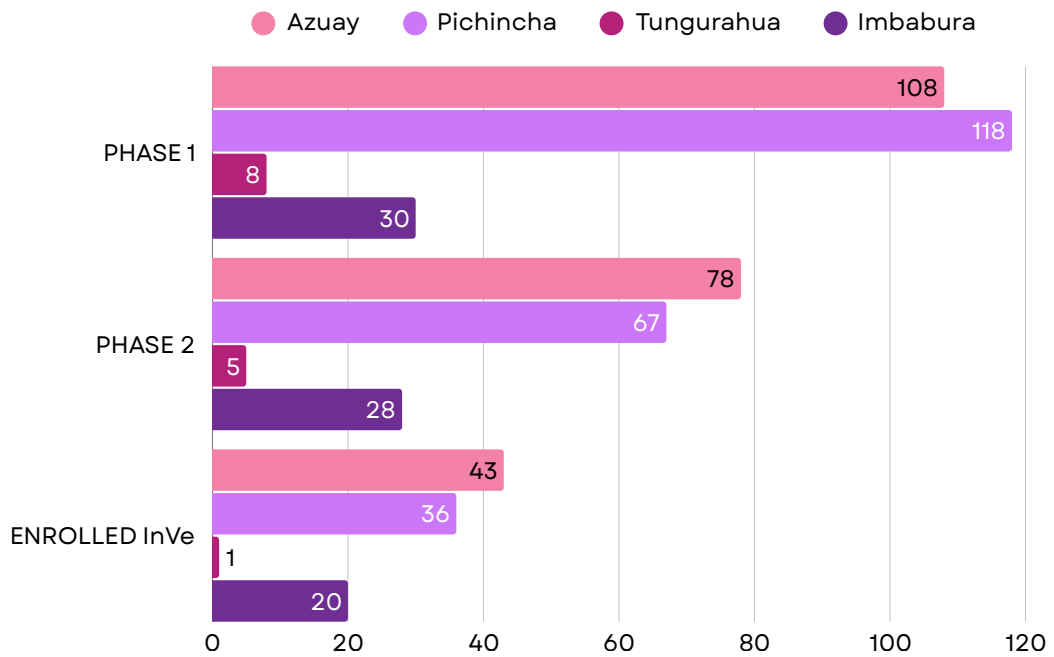

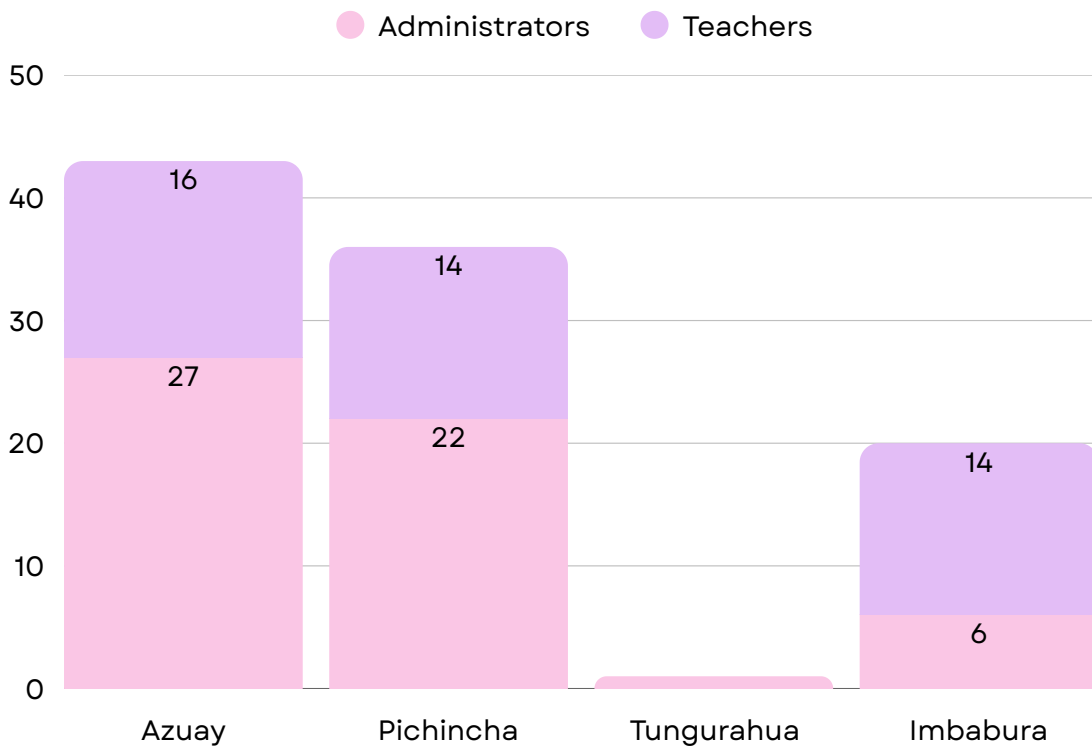
The process included an online application, in-person assessment, and final interviews. For the first time, a MINEDUC “referral list” was used, expanding the reach of recruitment.

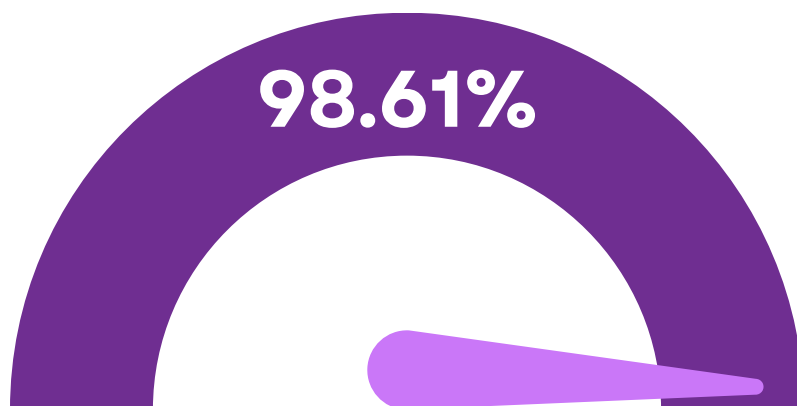

## Program NPS

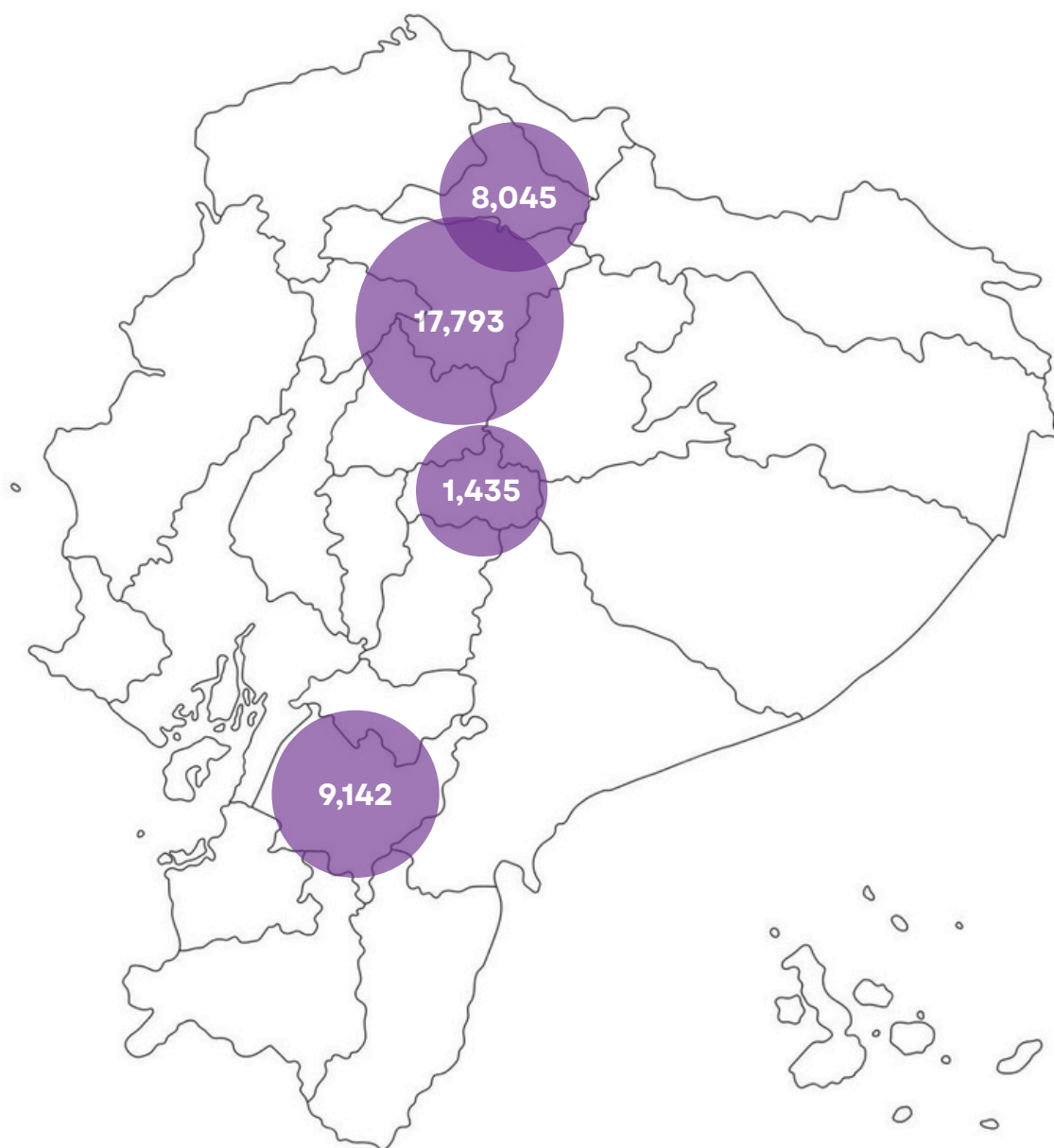
