

The Foundation for Aid to Children with Cancer of the State of Carabobo - FUNDANICA is a non-profit organization, established in 1995 on the initiative of Dr. Teresa Vanegas, Pediatric Oncologist at the Dr. Ángel Larralde Hospital in Carabobo, together with a group of mothers who shared the experience of having a child with cancer.

Patients from different parts of the country came to the hospital with solid tumors and liquid tumors (Leukemia), without resources to face the long periods of hospitalization, examinations and treatments. The high cost and the psychological impact that the diagnosis and treatment represent, motivated the creation of the foundation.


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How does FUNDANICA help?

Through the Comprehensive Patient Care Program, examinations and treatments are facilitated through a Letter of Guarantee for patients referred with a Medical Order from hospital centers; these during three important phases: Diagnosis, treatment and monitoring and control of the disease until remission. This includes: Imaging studies, laboratory tests, medical-surgical material, antineoplastic medications, biopsies, immunohistochemistry, radiotherapy (under agreements with specialized centers), special studies, nuclear medicine studies and support medications, among others, which consider the patient for pain treatment and psychosocial support for the family.


How does FUNDANICA help?






ANDREA'S STORY

STORY OF SOME PARENTS

Luciana Valentina was 5 years old, a normal, healthy, cheerful and mischievous girl. In 2008, we were on a trip to another city and noticed that Luciana was sleepy, sad, and had no energy. When we returned, Luciana was playing with her brother in the yard and was stung by a bug on the arm. The skin reaction, the pain, and the change in skin color to a striking red alerted us that something abnormal was happening.

STORY OF SOME PARENTS

We took her to the pediatrician who ordered general blood tests. Based on the results of the blood values, he immediately decided to hospitalize her and consult a hematology specialist. They performed a bone marrow puncture, and the result was a diagnosis of Acute Lymphoblastic Leukemia. Luciana received the order to receive chemotherapy for 25 months. Once this unexpected visit was accepted, we were lucky enough to learn about the existence of FUNDANICA through some friends, who gave us a warm welcome at their headquarters, restoring peace of mind with their psychological support, with their talks, with financial support in paying for tests and obtaining chemotherapy treatments, as well as medications that helped the girl recover from the effects of chemotherapy. Luciana felt very strong and the healing that came step by step was consolidated forever...! After the first 10 years she was declared medically healthy. Today in the year 2024, Luciana, thanks to GOD, science and FUNDANICA, is in remission, studying Dentistry and leading a normal life.




ACCOUNTABILITY 2023

Since the foundation was created (1995), there is a record of 1,910 patients, attending an average of 32 patients per month (new admissions, and for monitoring and treatment). Since that date, over the years, approximately 295 patients (children and adolescents) have been treated thanks to different strategic alliances with medical centers and laboratories, which provide the opportunity to perform the necessary studies for the diagnosis, re-evaluation and follow-up of the disease. These alliances have also allowed us to provide the antineoplastic and support medicines required for each case.




SOURCE OF INCOME







