OUR MISSION

History

The organization was formed in 2005 following a trip to Ethiopia when the founders visited the JRDC School in Shashamane Ethiopia. It introduced them to the fact that relatively small contributions can have a significant impact in the education of young people. The founders were inspired by the enthusiasm of the students and their genuine belief that achieving their educational objectives would help them improve their lives.

The academic success of students is often a collective effort. It is usually achieved with cooperation from students, teachers, parents, communities and philanthropic groups like ourselves.

Shashamane Sunrise currently sponsors ten (10) schools in five (5) countries serving some 2800 students.

- 1. Sponsorship of students to cover tuition, fees, books, and other school supplies.
- 2. Sponsorship of the School Lunch Program to provide free nutritious meals to students.
- 3. Funding school activities including teacher training, teacher salaries, equipment purchases and school capital improvement.

We also funded a volunteers led school renovation and landscaping project at the JRDC School.

Shashamane Sunrise donated school supplies, sporting equipment and library titles to sponsored schools. We also funded the completion of the Reading Resource Room/Library at our school in Jamaica, while in Trinidad and Tobago we funded the construction of a grow box and fish pond at one school, and donated multi-function printer/scanner/fax machines to two schools. We also organized a school visit by Standard IV students from Carapo Primary, Fishing Pond Primary, Salybia Primary to dinosaur exhibit "A T. Rex Named Sue" in Port of Spain, Trinidad, Shashamane Sunrise also convened the "Shash Camp", 1-week vacation Camp in Trinidad where some 70 students from 5 local primary schools were invited to the campus of UTT and they were exposed to careers in Science, Sports and the Arts. The camp received support from national leaders in these fields and several corporate sponsors.
