



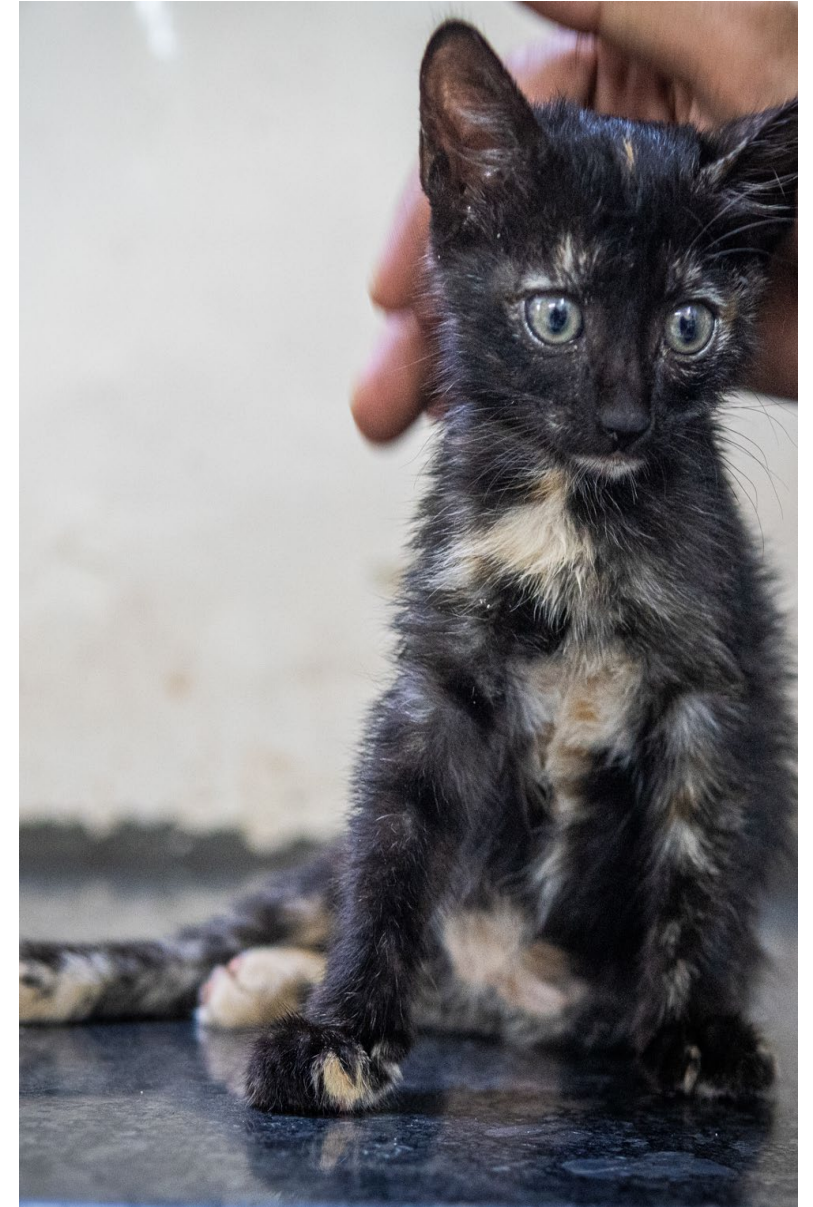

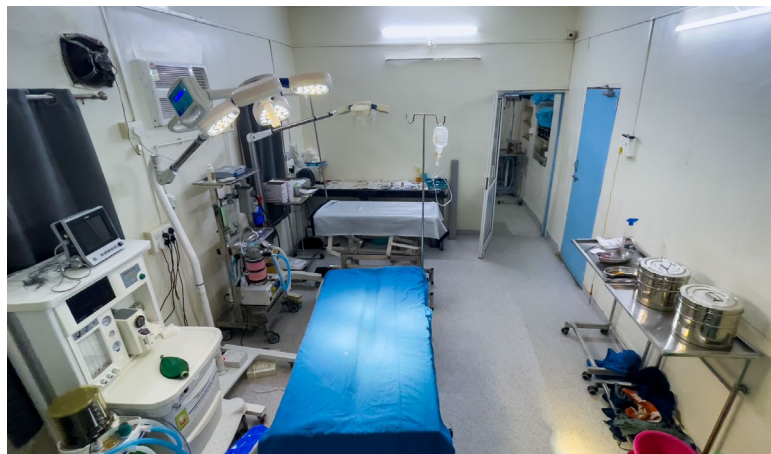

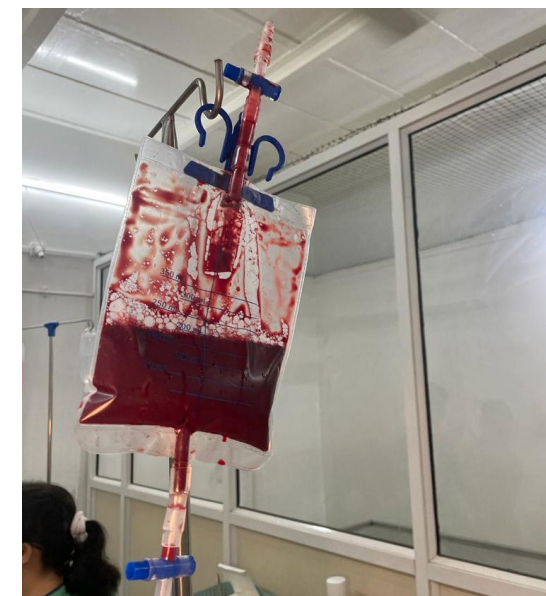
Rescue and Rehabilitation:

Animal Birth Control: Our commitment extends to controlling the stray animal population through sterilisation.

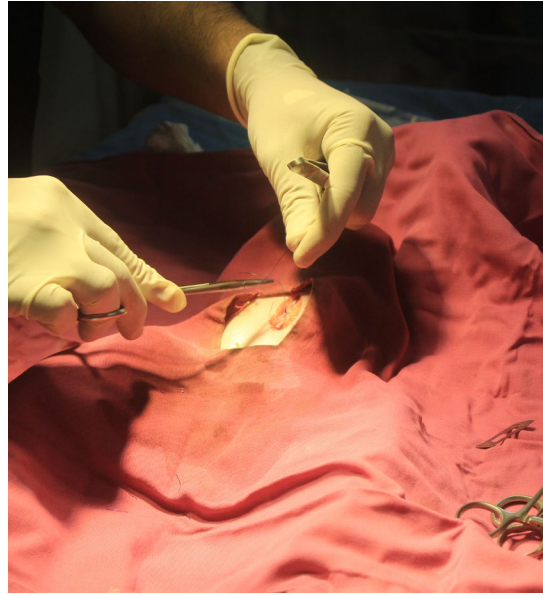
Community Clinic: Our community clinic serves as a lifeline for strays, providing free treatments to ensure no creature is left without care.





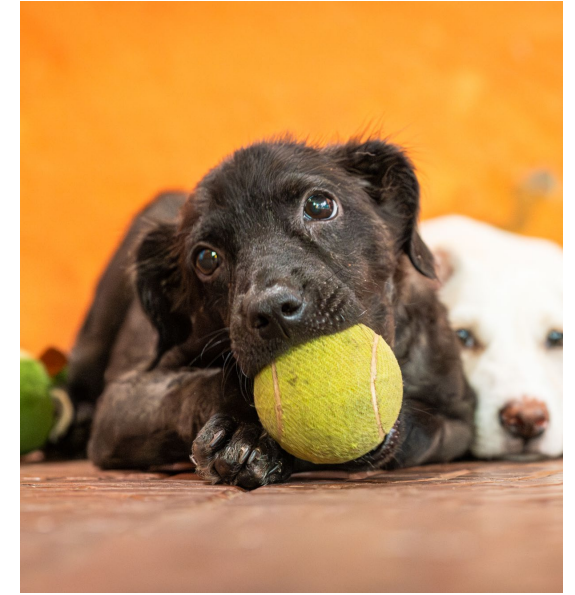
RESCUE AND REHABILITATION

COMMUNITY CLINIC

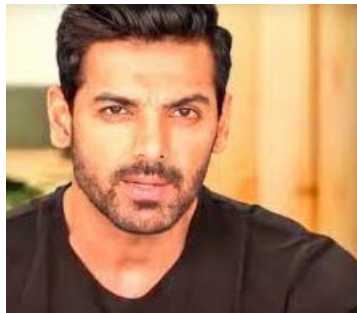

Veterinary In Rural India:

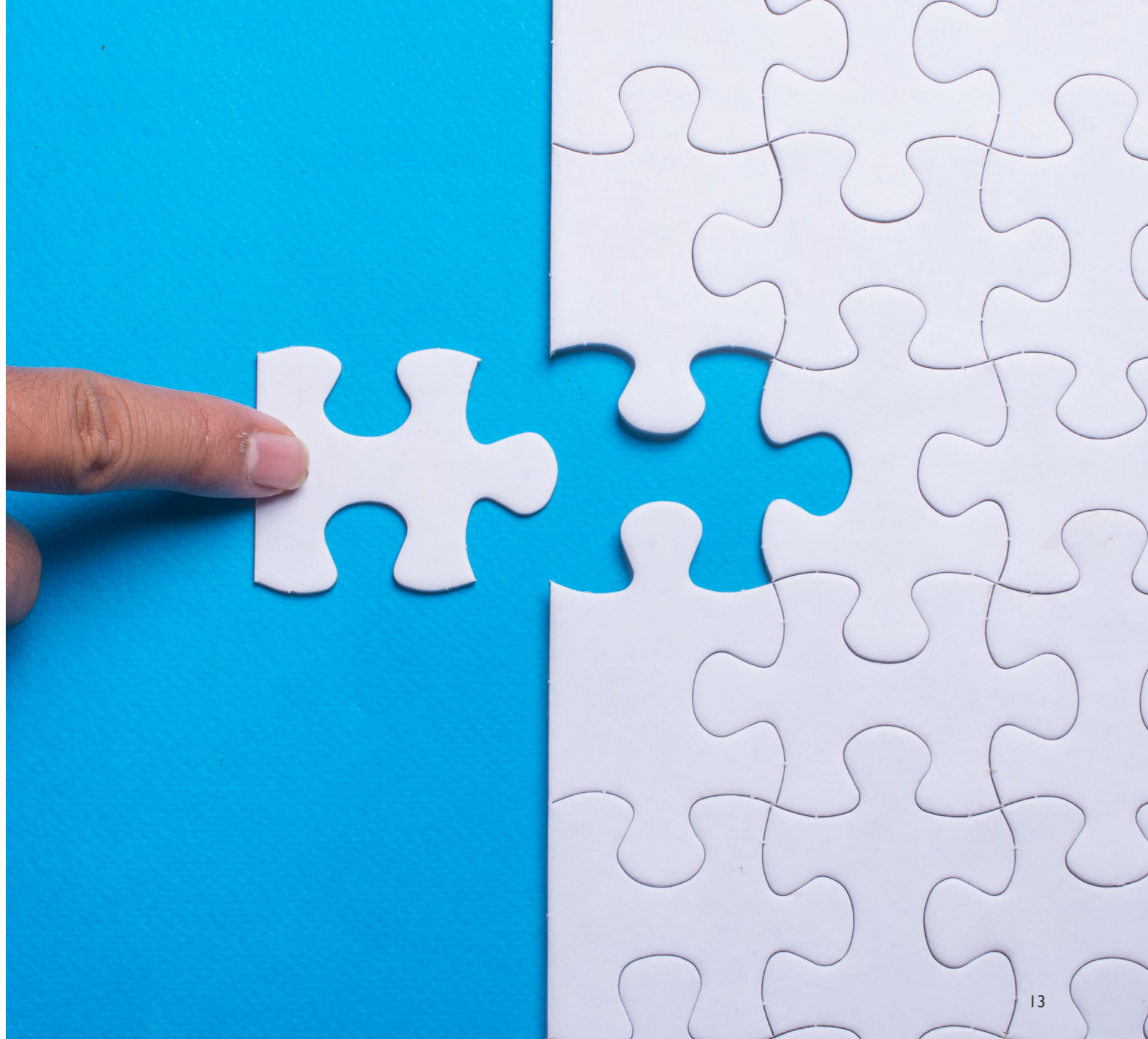
