

A UNIQUE MODEL

Designed to function in some of the world's most remote regions, the **PET Mobility Cart** is built on a sturdy wood/ steel frame. The vehicle is propelled by a hand-crank or pull handle and is fitted with solid, puncture-proof tires. Every cart is handcrafted by volunteers. Hundreds of dedicated volunteers at **Mobility Worldwide MO** - **Columbia**, along with refined purchasing practices, enable maximum efficiency in production. Another unique characteristic of the **PET Mobility Cart** is the compartment used to haul food, produce, tools or other necessities.Three versions (small, large and Pull) are produced and shipped at the low cost of \$300 each.

A UNIQUE HISTORY

1994 - **Mobility Worldwide** was founded by Reverend Mel West and missionary Larry Hills, with the help of Mr. Earl Miner, Product Designer. This was in response to the tragic loss of mobility in Zaire due to landmines and polio.

1995 – Field tests proved the cart design.

2000 – A production shop was opened in Columbia, MO. Shipments go to caring and reliable distribution partners who handle the shipping, importation and assessment of beneficiaries.

Today – The **PET Mobility Cart** has been deployed in over 100 countries and widely recognized

PET Mobility Carts are three-wheeled, off-road wheelchairs operated by hand power. Built by a faith-based, non-profit, volunteer organization, **PET Mobility Carts** are delivered at no cost to people in developing countries who are unable to walk due to illness, disease, birth defects or injuries, including those caused by landmines.



The PET Mobility Cart is a sturdy, three-wheeled vehicle propelled by hand-crank or pull handle which can be operated by a man, woman or child who is mobilityimpaired. The PET Mobility Cart enables an improved quality of life at work, school and home. Self-propelled units come in large and small sizes while the Pull cart is made for those without adequate upper body strength. More than 60,000 PET Mobility Carts have been distributed since the organization began in 1994. Each PET Mobility Cart is provided to the disabled at no cost to the individual.

The Need: The World Health Organization estimates that 70 million people worldwide need wheelchairs, yet only 5-15% of people have access.
