

# Project Documentation: Vaccinate, Sterilize, and Feed Vulnerable Pets in Coyaima

## 1. Project Summary

The project aims to improve the quality of life for 50 dogs and cats living in extreme poverty in Coyaima, Tolima, Colombia. Through a vaccination, deworming, and sterilization campaign, we seek to reduce the incidence of diseases and animal overpopulation. Additionally, five community feeding stations will be installed with an initial supply of one ton of balanced food to ensure daily feeding for the animals for one month.

## 2. Objectives

- **General Objective:** Improve animal welfare and reduce pet abandonment in Coyaima.
- **Specific Objectives:**
  - Vaccinate and deworm 50 dogs and cats.
  - Sterilize 50 animals to control unwanted reproduction.
  - Establish five community feeding stations for stray animals.
  - Promote awareness of responsible pet care within the community.

## 3. Budget

## 4. Action Plan

### 1. Phase 1: Preparation (Week 1-2)

- Identify the most vulnerable animals in the community.
- Coordinate with local veterinarians for the health campaign.
- Purchase food and materials for the feeding stations.

### 2. Phase 2: Implementation (Week 3-4)

- Conduct the vaccination and deworming campaign.
- Sterilize the selected animals.
- Install the five community feeding stations.
- Distribute food daily.

### 3. Phase 3: Monitoring and Evaluation (Week 5-6)

- Monitor the animals' health conditions.
- Assess the impact of the community feeding stations.
- Hold a community meeting to gather feedback.

## 5. Expected Impact

- **Disease reduction:** Vaccinating and deworming the animals is expected to lower the incidence of transmissible diseases.
- **Population control:** Sterilizing 50 animals will help prevent unwanted reproduction and reduce abandonment.
- **Improved quality of life:** Community feeding stations will ensure a consistent food supply for stray animals, improving their health and well-being.
- **Community awareness:** The project will promote responsible pet care and the importance of animal welfare in the community.
