# Results in Numbers



## SpivDiia for Children

- **163 838 children** received psychological and emotional support
- *a total of 44 075 counseling sessions were carried out all over Ukraine*

### Stories of our beneficiaries:

The photo features a family from Nikopol: mother Natalia and her two children, aged three and six. After getting tired of living under constant shelling, she made a tough decision to leave her apartment in the city, worried about the safety of her children.

This is how the family ended up living under the same roof as their grandmother, in a relatively quiet village in the Nikopol region. When Natalia saw the announcement of assistance from SpivDiia, she immediately applied:



"My grandmother is retired, I'm a single parent, and we don't have enough money to cover everything. When I saw an announcement in our community chat about the distribution of aid, I decided to apply as well. Now, thanks to these food kits, I can cook borscht for the kids and bake bread for us. I am very grateful for the support," shares the mother of two.



# SpivDiia. Psychological Support

Individual and group psychological counselling sessions as well as the organisation of outreach and awareness raising activities to support every Ukrainian in need

## Stories of our beneficiaries:

Anna (name has been redacted) is a young woman, 23 years old, who works in the field of human relations. For 6 months, she had been experiencing total fatigue and loss of purpose in life. She was also diagnosed with somatic conditions that complicated the situation. The woman felt emotionally exhausted, which led to her refusal to work and deterioration of relationships with her family.

The psychologist of SpivDiia helped to analyze the causes of emotional instability and master some grounding techniques, in particular, breathing techniques for emotion self-regulation. The therapy also included a look into the possible causes and mechanisms that negatively affected the patient. Thanks to the psychological counseling, Anna found personal resources to improve her emotional state, learned ways to support herself, and resumed her professional activities.





## SpivDiia. Career

We provide expert assistance in securing a job and establishing a career. We consult young people, create career strategies, help them adapt to changes in their occupation, and strengthen their knowledge and skills to land their dream job.



### Stories of our beneficiaries:

Ksenia Boyko is a girl with big dreams, without a definite plan. Everything changed when she sought career counseling. A little support, a lot of inspiration - and now, she is not just dreaming, but establishing her own business! Now Ksenia has her own SLP therapy practice and is moving forward with confidence.

# SpivDiia for Children

A network of projects and programs aimed at providing psychological and emotional support and access to education for children across Ukraine

## Stories of our beneficiaries:

Every child needs communication and high-quality communication is extremely important for their development. Anya is 6 years old and has been attending one of the SpivDiia spaces for over a year. At the beginning of Anya's acquaintance with the mentors of SpivDiia, the girl did not speak or communicate in other ways, did not participate in games and activities. She just stood quietly and watched, but did not make any moves to engage. Other kids wanted to befriend her, so it was very important that someone showed them how to do it. Together, we invited Anya to play games, involved her in creative activities, and helped her whenever she needed it.

After a few sessions, the girl began to participate in exercises and games on her own, and after a while, she started talking. She began to answer questions briefly and gesture vigorously.



Now Anya visits various rehabilitation centers in the city, but still comes to the SpivDiia space every month.



## SpivDiia.Health

Through the program area of SpivDiia Health, in collaboration with UNICEF and with the support of the Ministry of Health of Ukraine, we are implementing the Home-Birth Care project, introducing a system of home visits to women post- labor and parents or guardians with children aged 0 to 3 years. These visits provide comprehensive medical and social support on the path of parenthood in difficult times.





## P2P

Through this project we aim to connect and unite people across the country, to help each other and support everyone in need during this difficult time through collective efforts

### Stories of our beneficiaries:

This is the second time Karyna from Kyiv has applied to SpivDiia with a sincere desire to help those who have suffered from the ruthless attack of the Russian Federation. This time, her heart responded to the story of Alevtina, a woman who was forced to leave her hometown of Mykolaiv with her family. Their home was completely destroyed by shelling, and the worst part is that they lost a loved one, their grandmother, who was killed in the attack.

Now Alevtina and her family live in Lutsk, trying to start a new life.

Upon hearing about this story, Karyna decided to reach out to help again. She collected women's spring clothes to send them by Nova Poshta at her own expense so that the family could have the necessary things.
