Subject: Progress Report July 2025 - Sponsor a Child to Stay in School (69270)				

Within the framework of the Siembra CORPELUVA program, and under the Zulia Guerrero scholarship program, we have continued working tirelessly to ensure that children and young people in vulnerable situations in Cali, Colombia, remain in the school system, develop their skills, and build a future full of hope.

Between April and July 30, 2025, we have made significant progress that we want to share with you, our GlobalGiving partners, who make this dream possible.

Main results: To date, we have received 14 donations through the platform and local partners; nine of these scholarships cover the entire year for nine students, who were selected from grades 9, 10, and 11, as they are the most at risk of dropping out of school. This strategic decision seeks to ensure that students who are close to completing their education do not drop out due to lack of resources. Thanks to these donations, their families have received financial relief in tuition, uniforms, school supplies, and psychosocial support, ensuring their continued education until the end of the year.

Activities developed:

During these months we have implemented a series of concrete actions to strengthen the impact of the plan:

- Benefit delivery and follow-up: Sponsored students received school kits, uniforms, and support to cover their educational costs, which was documented in photographs that reflect the beneficiaries' joy and motivation.
- Motivation and career guidance workshops: We held four meetings with students and parents, working on self-esteem, personal goals, peaceful conflict resolution, and building life plans.
- Campaigns and partner management: We continue with social media campaigns, emails to businesses, community meetings, and guided tours of our institutions so potential donors can learn more about how we work.
- Preventing school dropouts: Thanks to collaboration with teachers and families, we ensured that no sponsored student dropped out during this period.
- Family support: We engage families in positive parenting workshops, strengthening their educational commitment from home.

Indicators as of July 30, 2025:

- Total donations received: 14
- Full scholarships awarded: 9
- Children directly benefited: 9
- Children partially benefited or with specific support: 5
- Workshops held: 4
- Families participating in workshops: 47
- Institutional visits received: 6 (companies, foundations and volunteers interested in supporting)

Stories and testimonies:

Valeria (10th grade) told us:

"If it weren't for the scholarship, I wouldn't have been able to continue studying this semester. Now I have the hope of finishing high school and becoming a nurse. Thank you to everyone who believes in me."

Juan Sebastián's (11th grade) mother wrote to us:

"I don't know how to thank you. Your support came at the most difficult time. I couldn't afford to pay for school anymore, and now my son will be able to finish high school."

Current challenges:

Despite the progress, the need remains immense. Our goal for this year is to secure 147 full scholarships, targeting the most urgent cases, as their families are on the verge of withdrawing them from school due to a lack of resources. In total, our universe of at-risk students is 320, but 147 are the immediate priority. We have resorted to various strategies to keep them engaged, but there is a real risk that some will not be able to continue starting in September if we do not secure more support.

Next steps:

- Continue strengthening fundraising campaigns through GlobalGiving, Baki, and direct donations.
- Manage agreements with companies and international partners that can adopt group scholarships.
- Expand workshops to include basic technology, performing arts, and youth leadership.
- Organize meetings with donors to showcase progress and motivate them to continue supporting.

With your help, we continue to sow dreams and fight to ensure that none of our children drop out of school.



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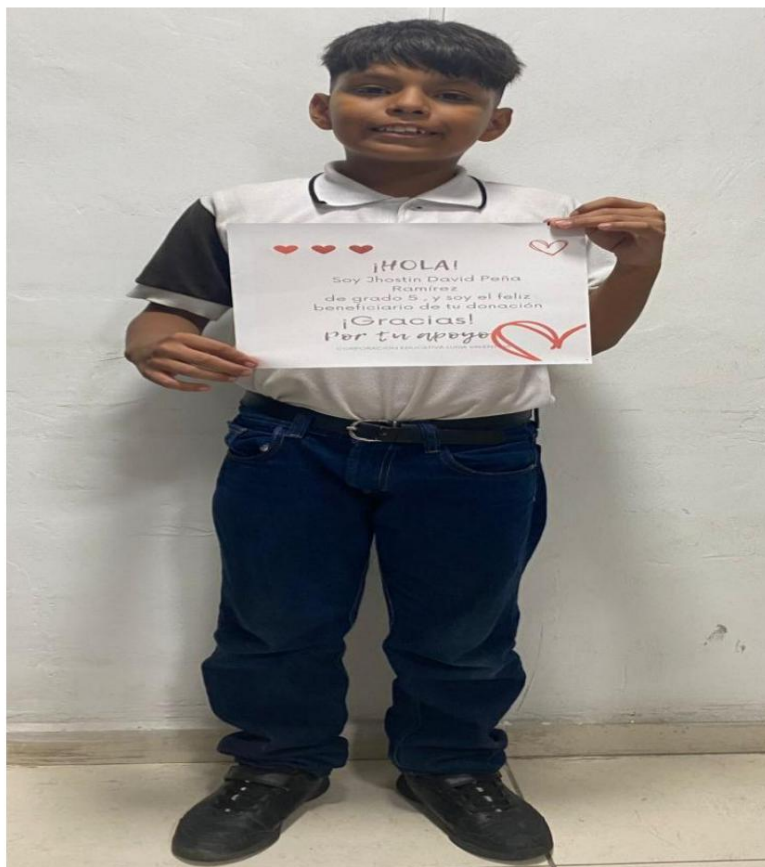
