Project Summary



This project brings two week-long short course programmes to 150 university students and teachers in Nigeria, helping them build real-world skills for today's job market.

Professors Without Borders will send five volunteer educators to the University of Lagos (UNILAG) from 21–26 July. There, they'll lead classes on Financial Literacy in Africa, Social Entrepreneurship, Research Methods and Gender Equity, plus run Career Skills Workshops covering Use of AI, Interview Prep, CV writing and more.

The team will then head to Ekiti State University the following week. Here our partners have requested courses on AI in the classroom, teaching and research methods, IT tools for industry relevance, and the Sustainable Development Goals with a focus on cultural sustainability.

This project strengthens our partnerships with UNILAG (since 2022) and Ekiti State University (since 2023) to further our efforts to help their students grow professionally and give local teachers new tools and perspectives for effective teaching.
