- b) Our mission is to change the lives of such children - by providing them with long-term care.** This includes basic needs, education and healthcare, and skills to transform them into responsible citizens.



PROGRAMS RUN BY SPHOORTI

a)Sphoorti Children's Home - Providing long term care to 60 girl children in need of care and protection



b)Sphoorti Model School – Providing free education, books, stationery, uniforms and transportation to underprivileged children from the nearby villages

c) **Education Scholarship Program** – Providing educational support to children pursuing STD XI, STD XII and higher education

d) **Sphoorti Akshara Yagnam Project** – Running 60 After – School study centers for 1500 children from slum and tribal neighbourhoods in Tirupati and Madanapalle

e) **Project Kappaladoddi** – Supporting 50 destitute elderly couples who were formerly weavers and not in a position to earn a livelihood in the present times



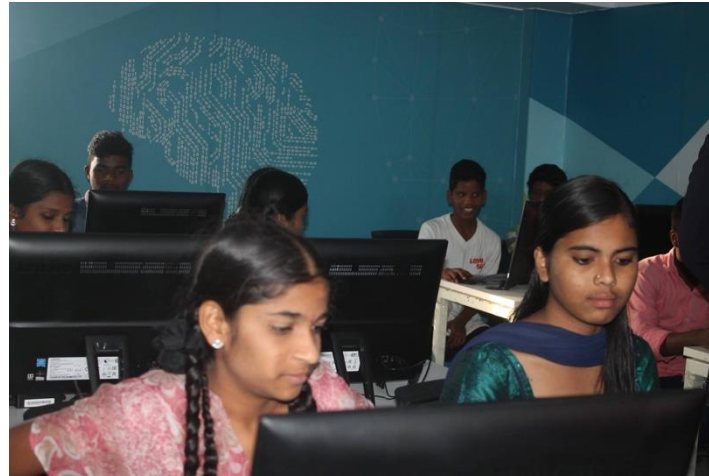
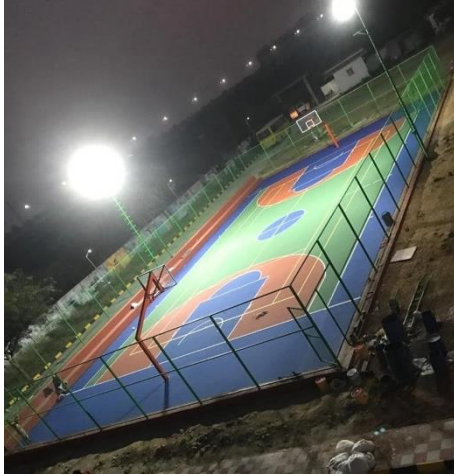
f) **Tailoring Training Centers** in Tirupati. Trained 100 widowed and destitute women in 2021



g) **Covid relief** – Provisions to migrant and impoverished families and private school teachers during 2020-22. Received appreciation from Society for Cyberabad Security Council

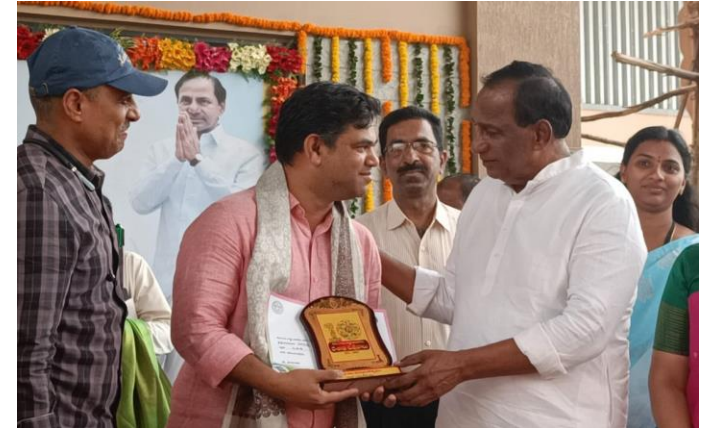

FUTURE PLANS

- a) **Expansion of School** – We will admit more than 100 new children in the Sphoorti Model School
- b) **Campus Security** – We will be installing more than 30 new Solar Street Lights and Barbed Wire Fencing
- c) **Rainwater Harvesting and Water Recycling**– Keeping in view the chances of groundwater depletion and increased water consumption, we will install a Rainwater Harvesting System and Water Recycling System
- d) **An Ambulance and Para Medical Staff** – We plan to have a functional ambulance and required staff
- e) **Green Cover** – We plan to reduce our carbon footprint by increasing greenery in the campus
- f) **Indoor Sports hub** – We plan to build an indoor sports hub for our students.
