In Nigeria's red-light communities, many girls face trafficking before reaching adulthood. This project gives 100 daughters of sex workers education, daily meals, vocational training, and trusted mentors, creating safer paths to learning, independence, and a future free from exploitation.



EDUCATION

The Challenge

Girls born to sex workers face poverty, violence, neglect, and deep social stigma. These pressures push them out of school and into dangerous situations, leaving them highly vulnerable to trafficking and exploitation.



The Risk

Without safe environments, education, vocational skills, and trusted mentors, these girls have few choices. Urgent intervention is needed to break the cycle and protect their futures from harm.

Project Goal

- Protect 100 adolescent girls living in red-light communities from trafficking and exploitation.
- Provide education support, nutritious daily meals, vocational skills training, mentorship, and safe spaces.
- Every girl deserves safety, hope, and the chance to build a brighter future – free from exploitation and full of possibility.

* Project Activities

- Supply school uniforms, books, and learning materials.
- Provide daily nutritious meals during learning sessions.
- Organize after-school tutoring and academic support for girls in the program.

- Deliver vocational training in tailoring, hairdressing, crafts, and digital skills.
- Conduct life skills, leadership, and child protection awareness workshops to build confidence and safety.

- Provide mentorship through trained female volunteers.
- Monitor progress, offer follow-up support, and refer girls experiencing abuse or exploitation to appropriate protection services.



Target Beneficiaries

- 100 adolescent girls living in red-light communities
- Daughters of sex workers
- Girls at risk of trafficking and exploitation
- Girls from extremely low-income households
- Mothers seeking safer opportunities for their daughters

BUDGE

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Budget Overview

Total Project Budget: \$30,000 USD

This budget supports 100 adolescent girls with school supplies, daily nutritious meals, vocational training, safe learning spaces, mentorship, and child protection services. A detailed breakdown of all allocations is provided on the following page. Every dollar invested directly protects a girl from trafficking and opens a door to a safer future.

EDUCATION

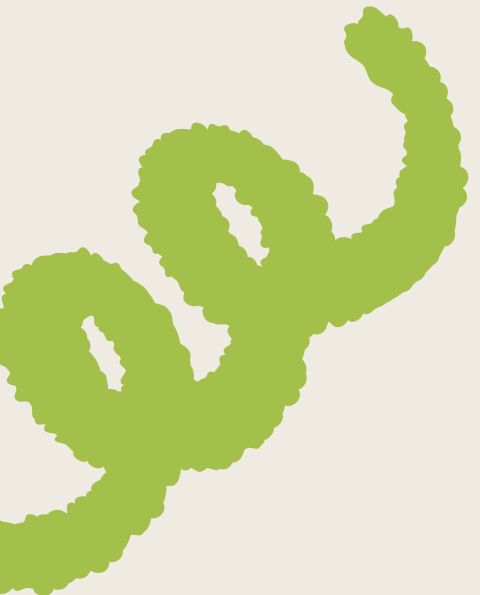
Budget Overview

- School Supplies & Materials: \$7,000
- Daily Meals & Nutrition: \$6,000
- Vocational Training Materials: \$5,000
- Safe Learning Space & Activities: \$4,000

Allocation

- Mentorship & Life Skills: \$2,500
- Project Coordination & Admin: \$2,500
- Monitoring & Documentation: \$1,500
- Child Protection & Referrals: \$1,500



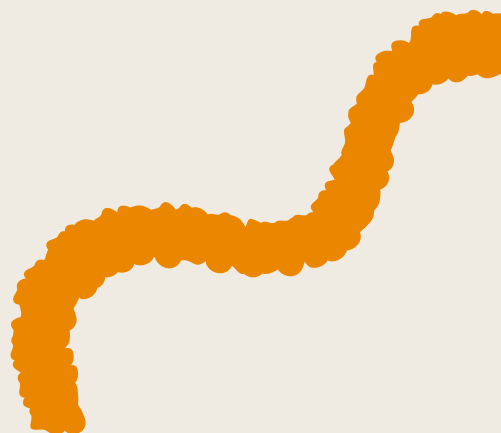


Contributions create safe learning environments, fund mentorship and life skills sessions, and enable child protection services – giving vulnerable girls safer choices and brighter futures.
