Fauza Foundation is dedicated to supporting underprivileged learners in Kenya by providing scholarships to students at the university, college, and primary levels. This proposal seeks funding through Global Giving to support 70 learners in accessing quality education. The grant will cover tuition fees, learning materials, food, accommodations and other essential educational expenses, enabling these students to pursue their studies without financial constraints.

2. Project Description

Children in Kenya face financial difficulties that hinder their education as some are neglected, abandoned, or come from broken families, leaving them without support or guidance. Fauza Foundation aims to bridge this gap by offering scholarships to 70 deserving learners—20 university/ College students and 50 primary pupils. The funding will ensure that these students receive adequate financial support to continue their education and improve their future prospects. Currently, we have 10 learners who completed their O level under Fauza Foundation but unable to proceed to the next level due to some financial constraints.

3. Objectives

- To provide financial support for 70 learners in Kenya.
- To improve access to quality education for underprivileged children.
- To alleviate financial burdens on families struggling to pay for education.
- To enhance academic performance and retention rates among sponsored students.
