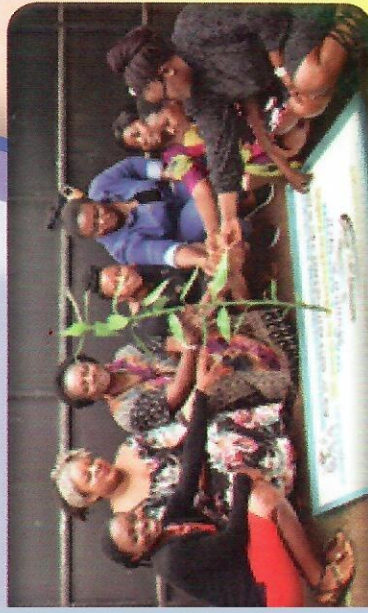

- ❖ Proposed a draft law on Child Marriage to government and parliament for adoption (2019)
