1. Executive Summary

Education is a fundamental human right and a transformative force capable of breaking the chains of poverty. However, in Tanzania, particularly in the Arusha and Manyara regions, thousands of children remain on the margins, unable to pursue their studies due to hidden school costs, insufficient supplies, and limited family resources.

The **Sponsor a Child’s Education Project** by **TAJPI Tanzania** bridges this gap by offering holistic, long-term sponsorships to vulnerable young learners. Each sponsorship covers tuition, uniforms, textbooks, daily meals, health check-ups, and mentorship—providing the dignity, confidence, and tools necessary for success.

By sponsoring a child, you not only remove financial barriers but also instill hope and opportunity. Together, we can open the door to brighter futures—one child at a time.

2. Project Background

While primary schooling in Tanzania is officially free, families still struggle with:

- **Uniforms & Supplies:** Required uniforms, shoes, stationery, and exam fees cost up to \$150 per year.
- **Nutrition:** Hungry children cannot concentrate; lack of meals leads to absenteeism.
- **Distance & Labor:** Long walks to school and pressures to contribute to household income pull children out of class.
- **Limited Caregiver Support:** Orphans and children in single-parent homes lack the guidance and resources to stay in school.

In Arusha and Manyara, these obstacles drive high dropout rates and poor academic results. TAJPI collaborates with local schools, community leaders, and caregivers to identify and support those most at risk.

3. Project Goal

Sponsor 100 vulnerable children annually in Arusha and Manyara to ensure uninterrupted access to quality primary and secondary education.

4. Objectives

1. **Eliminate financial hurdles** by covering school fees and exam costs.
2. **Equip learners** with uniforms, books, and essential supplies.
3. **Promote well-being** through daily meals and health check-ups.
4. **Enhance retention & performance** with regular attendance tracking and academic follow-ups.
5. **Foster community engagement** by involving parents, schools, and local stakeholders.

5. Target Beneficiaries

- **Ages:** 3–17 years
- **Profiles:** Orphans, children from single-parent or extremely low-income households, those at risk of dropping out.
- **Selection:** Nominations via schools, community referrals, and TAJPI outreach.

6. Sponsorship Package & Costs

2. **Sponsorship Delivery:** Distribute uniforms, supplies, and meal vouchers at term start.
3. **Monitoring & Support:** Conduct quarterly school visits, track attendance, and host mentorship sessions.
4. **Community Engagement:** Hold biannual meetings to educate families on the value of sustained schooling.

- **Metrics Tracked:** Attendance, retention rates, academic results, and well-being indicators.
- **Sponsor Reports:**
 - Biannual child updates (photos, letters, and progress summaries).
 - Annual financial transparency report.
 - Certificate of appreciation.

Budget Notes and Assumptions

- **Direct Sponsorship Costs** cover the essential package per child, ensuring tuition, materials, nutrition, health, and psychosocial support.
- **Optional Add-On Kits** (bicycles, backpacks, raincoats) are available for sponsors seeking to further reduce barriers related to travel, storage of supplies, and weather. Quantities listed assume demand by the most vulnerable, but can be adjusted.
- **Program Administration** includes staff salaries (coordinator and part-time field officers), modest office overhead, and communications necessary to coordinate with schools and sponsors.
- **Monitoring & Evaluation** ensures accountability and program quality via regular site visits, data management tools, sponsor reporting materials, and an annual stakeholder workshop.
