SpivDiia for Children

is a network of projects and programs aimed at providing psycho-emotional support and access to education for children and adolescents all across Ukraine.



FACTS:

there are 4.8 million IDPs in Ukraine
52% of them are children aged 5-17

Every fifth child has a **sleep disorder**, and every tenth child has a reduced **desire to communicate**, nightmares, and memory loss.

The most common symptom is “**Emotional outbursts**” - a condition in which the mood changes drastically from good to bad.



SOLUTION:

Implementation of MHPSS programs



Psycho-emotional support is an intervention aimed at building the resilience of individuals, families, and communities to strengthen their capacity for recovery and adaptation.

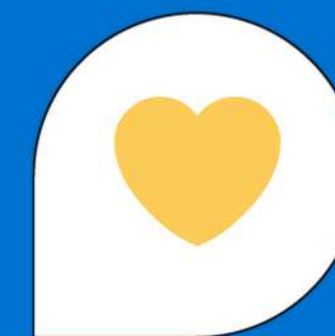


Such support allows people to recover from the consequences of crisis events and helps them cope with similar situations in the future.

Our mission is to restore and preserve the mental health of children for the future of Ukraine

Children affected by the war, including internally displaced children and children with disadvantaged social status.



Target audience: children aged 5-17, divided into age groups of 5-7, 8-10, 11-13, and 14-17.

IMPACT OF THE PROGRAM:

75%

of parents surveyed say that their children need the project's workshops to communicate with peers and find friends

70%

note that the components of the training program have a positive effect on the child's concentration, they become interested

70%

of parents claim that their child's emotional well-being is cared for in the program space





BEFORE

participating in activities in the space, parents noticed the following in their children

50% Couldn't be "pulled away" from their phone/tablet

40% emotional outbursts

30% lack of focus

25% Irritability, difficulty connecting with others, increased sense of fear

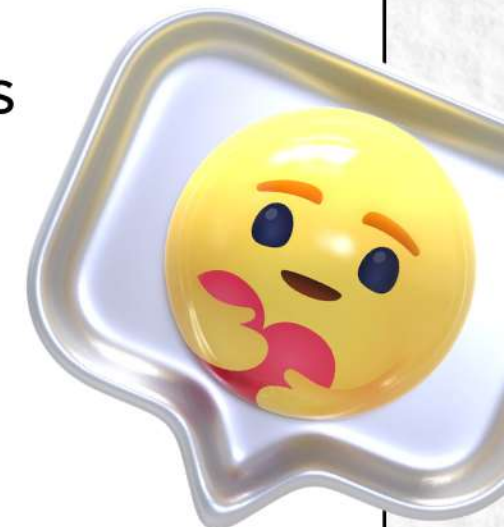
— A newfound interest in attending sessions, sharing experiences, and expressing feelings

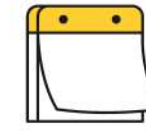
