To provide medical, nutritional, psychological and spiritual support to those living with **HIV or AIDS** and their families.

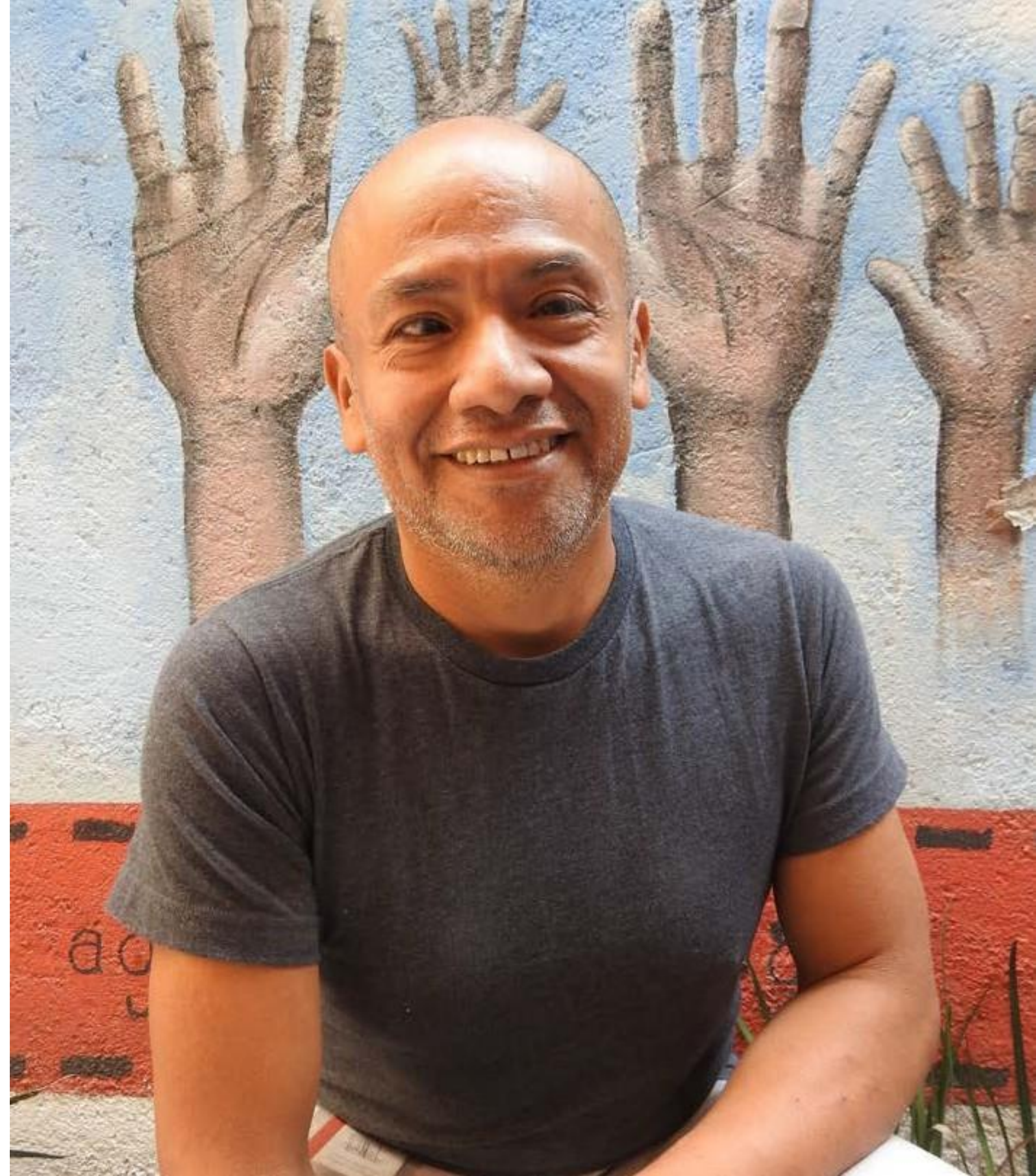


To decrease the rate of **HIV** infections in Mexico through prevention strategies.

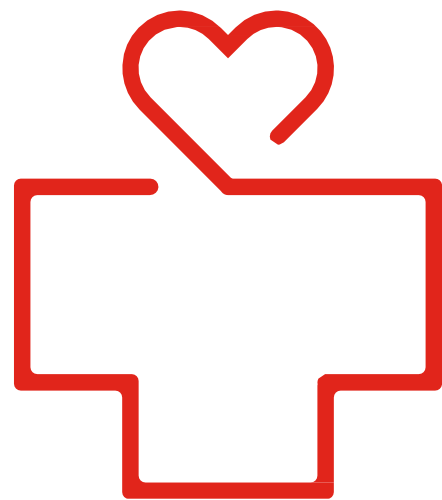
# EDUCATION AND PREVENTION
