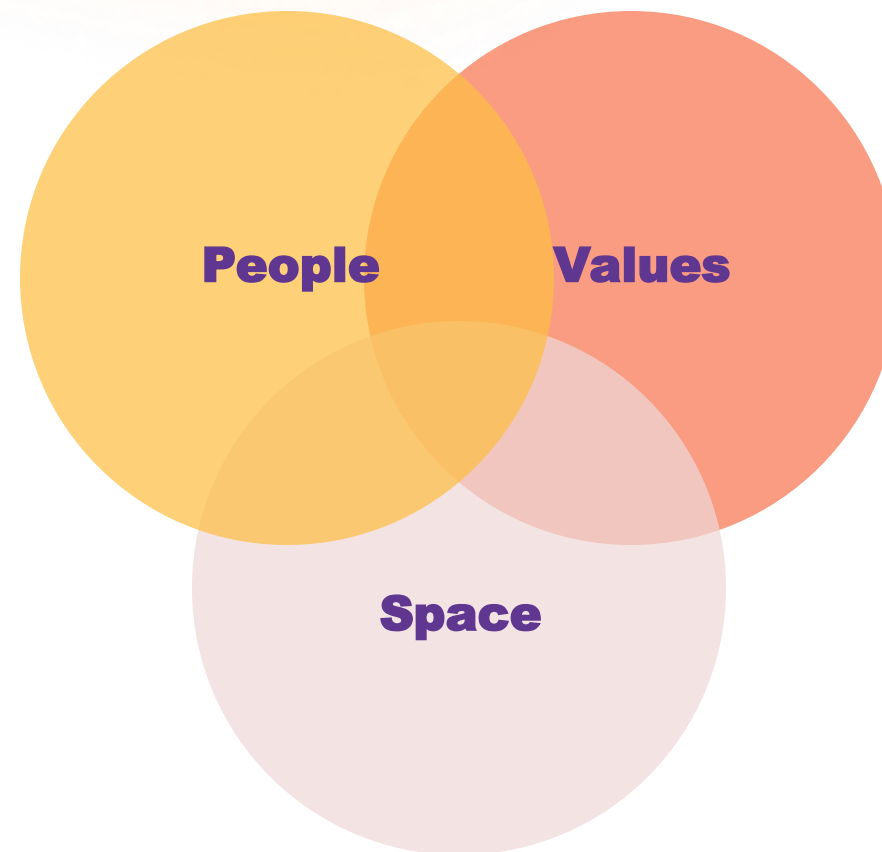


● **Purpose of Spilnota project**

Providing psychological, medical, educational support, career guidance, and promoting social integration of adolescents from vulnerable categories.





Project issues



♥ For teenagers and youth

♥ For the community and society

This youth has an offer of activities and development, social integration, civic education of youth is taking place (we form conscious citizens)



Target audience of the project

The project positions itself as a project for every teenager and young person from 14 to 23 years old, however, as specialists implementing this program, we have in mind teenagers from vulnerable categories:

- Orphans and children deprived of parental care (status children)
- Children who have/had experience of living in institutional settings
- Children affected by war
- Children who are internally displaced
- Children from families in difficult life circumstances

Main directions of the project



Non-formal education

These are courses on worldviews that are important for social adaptation in the community. We are talking about financial literacy, legal literacy, social literacy (communication, relationships), media literacy, sexual literacy, healthy lifestyle. Also included are topics on democracy, leadership, and project management. Also included is mentoring.



Career guidance

a career guidance course, the result of which will be the writing of a career map for each participant. The course presents topics on finding oneself, getting to know different professions, getting to know professional people and their experience, excursions. It is also planned within this direction - corporate mentoring - the opportunity to do internships with local partners



Mental and physical support

group adolescent groups with a psychologist/psychotherapist, as well as individual psychological support. This also includes medical support for adolescents and young people from institutional settings.



Educational support

pedagogical support through tutoring to prepare for the NMT exam and support for pedagogical knowledge according to the required level according to the school curriculum. As well as courses according to career aspirations.

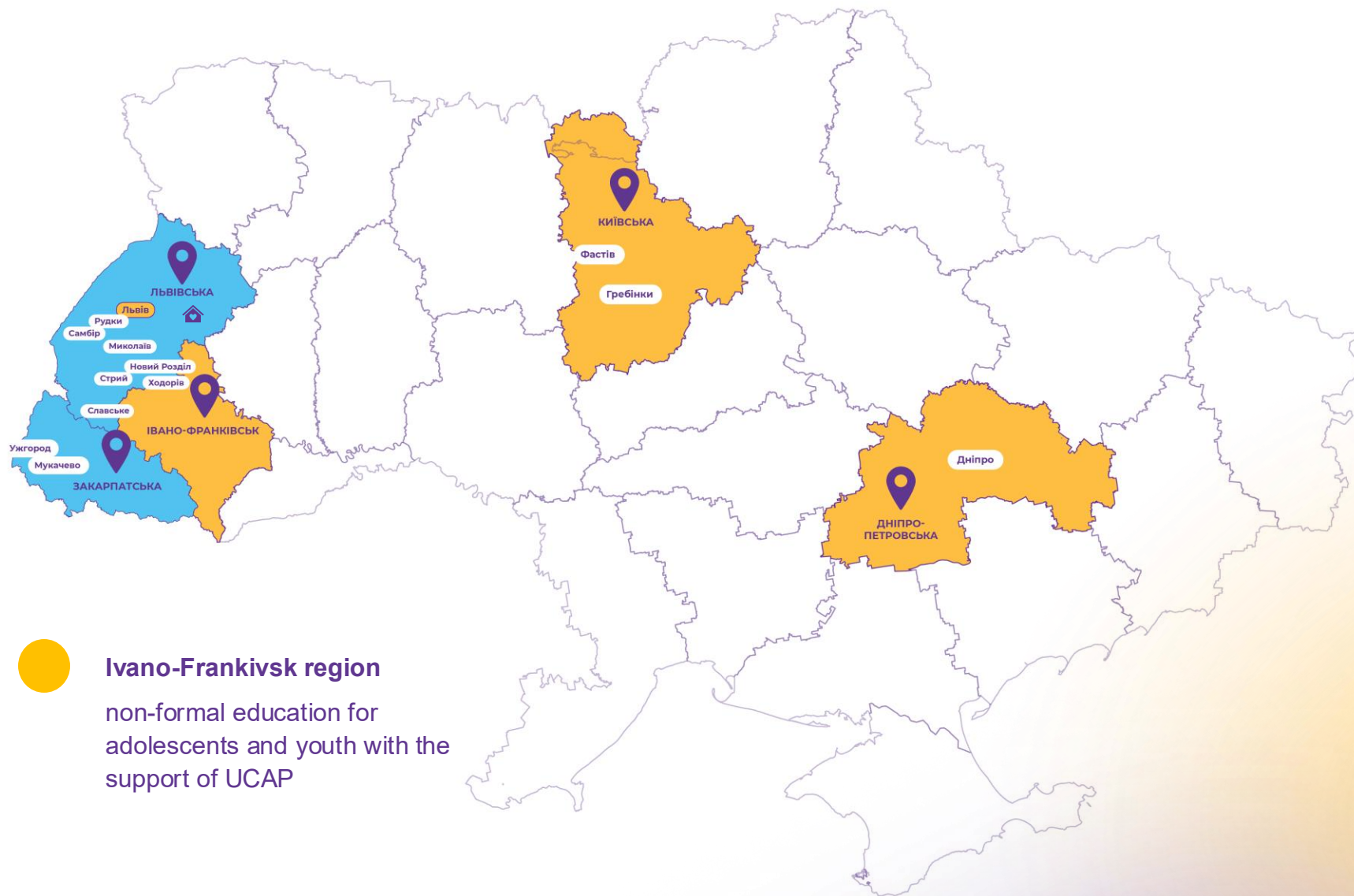

received individual training courses

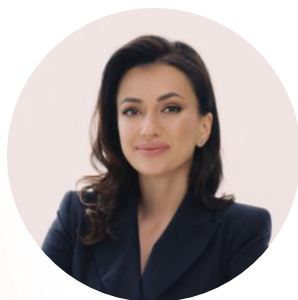
