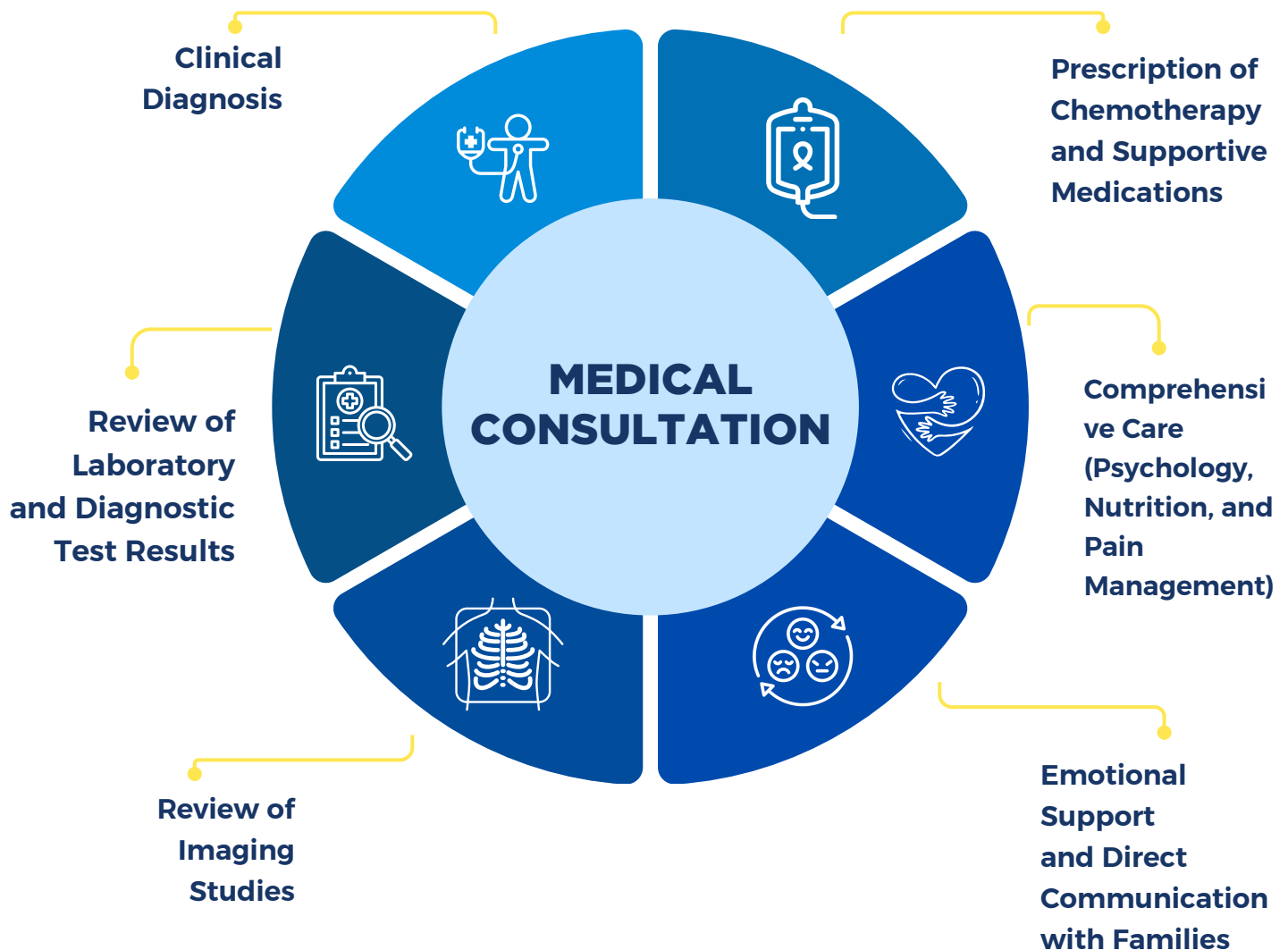

She often helps her mother at the family's shaved ice stand and enjoys being outdoors while continuing to regain her strength.

Faith has been a very important part of her journey. She has returned to participating in church activities, attending worship gatherings where she joins others in prayer, singing, and fellowship. She also looks forward to pursuing one of her biggest dreams: learning to play the piano.



Although she is still adapting to the physical changes left by her treatment and continues to use crutches as part of her rehabilitation, Glenda remains optimistic and full of hope. She is also planning to return to school next year, giving herself the time she needs to fully recover before beginning this new stage.

Seeing her smile, watching her hair grow back, and hearing her talk about her future plans is a beautiful reminder of everything she has overcome.
