We began our first Scratch lessons in September, starting with the car project, and now we're already close to completing all the Scratch units.

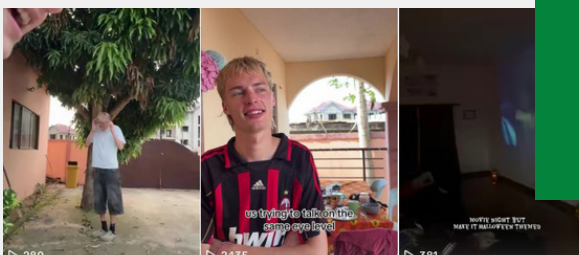

His organisation focuses on collecting old devices and shipping them to NGOs that need them. They support not only with electronic devices but also with books, helping organisations gain access to important learning resources.

Thanks to their support, we were able to receive three new laptops for our equipment. This allows us to provide more laptops at public schools, so students no longer have to share devices during lessons.
