SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT GOALS

1. NO POVERTY

End poverty in all its forms everywhere. This includes eradicating extreme poverty, reducing the number of people living below national poverty lines, and ensuring equal access to economic resources and basic services.

2. ZERO HUNGER

Achieve food security and improved nutrition while promoting sustainable agriculture. This includes ending hunger, doubling agricultural productivity, and ensuring resilient food production systems.

3. GOOD HEALTH AND WELL-BEING

Ensure healthy lives and promote well-being for all ages. This goal aims to reduce maternal mortality, end epidemics like HIV/AIDS, malaria, and tuberculosis, and provide universal health coverage.

4. QUALITY EDUCATION

Ensure inclusive and equitable quality education and promote lifelong learning. Key areas include universal primary and secondary education, equal access to technical and higher education, and increased literacy rates.

5. GENDER EQUALITY

Achieve gender equality and empower all women and girls. This includes ending discrimination and violence against women, ensuring equal participation in decision-making, and addressing barriers to economic and educational opportunities.

6. CLEAN WATER AND SANITATION

Ensure availability and sustainable management of water and sanitation for all. The goal focuses on providing safe and affordable drinking water, sanitation, and hygiene while reducing water pollution.

7. AFFORDABLE AND CLEAN ENERGY

Ensure access to affordable, reliable, and sustainable energy for all. This includes increasing the share of renewable energy, improving energy efficiency, and ensuring access to modern energy services.

8. DECENT WORK AND ECONOMIC GROWTH

Promote sustained, inclusive, and sustainable economic growth, full and productive employment, and decent work for all. Priorities include reducing unemployment, ensuring labor rights, and encouraging innovation.

9. INDUSTRY INNOVATION AND INFRASTRUCTURE

Build resilient infrastructure, promote inclusive industrialization, and foster innovation. The goal supports investments in infrastructure and research to enhance productivity and sustainable development.

10. REDUCED INEQUALITIES

Reduce inequality within and among countries. This includes addressing income disparities, ensuring social and economic inclusion, and improving representation for marginalized groups.

11. SUSTAINABLE CITIES AND COMMUNITIES

Make cities inclusive, safe, resilient, and sustainable. Focus areas include affordable housing, public transportation, reducing urban pollution, and protecting cultural and natural heritage.

12. RESPONSIBLE CONSUMPTION AND PRODUCTION

Ensure sustainable consumption and production patterns. This involves reducing waste, promoting recycling, and encouraging sustainable resource use in industries and households.

13. CLIMATE ACTION

Take urgent action to combat climate change and its impacts. This includes implementing mitigation strategies, improving disaster resilience, and integrating climate change measures into policies.

14. LIFE BELOW WATER

Conserve and sustainably use oceans, seas, and marine resources. Efforts focus on reducing marine pollution, protecting aquatic ecosystems, and ensuring sustainable fishing practices.

15. LIFE ON LAND

Protect, restore, and promote sustainable use of terrestrial ecosystems. This involves combating desertification, halting deforestation, conserving biodiversity, and restoring degraded land.

16. PEACE, JUSTICE AND STRONG INSTITUTIONS

Promote peaceful and inclusive societies, provide access to justice, and build accountable institutions. This includes reducing violence, ensuring legal identity for all, and fighting corruption.

17. PARTNERSHIPS FOR THE GOALS

Strengthen implementation and global partnerships for sustainable development. This goal emphasizes international cooperation, financial resources, technology transfer, and capacity-building.

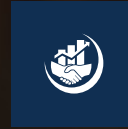

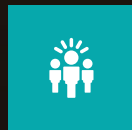

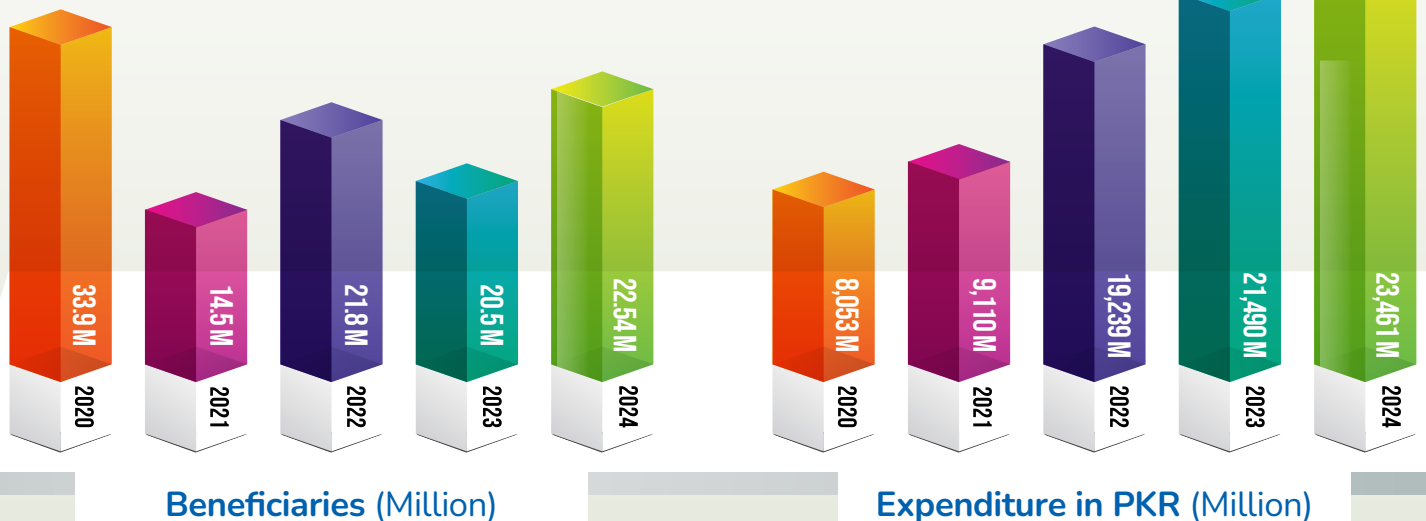

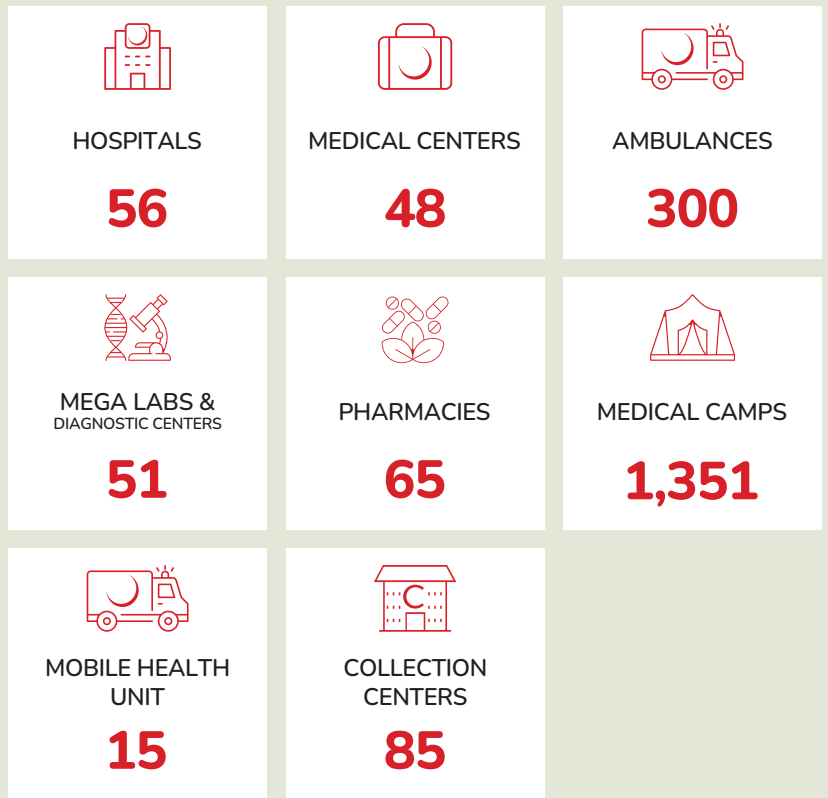

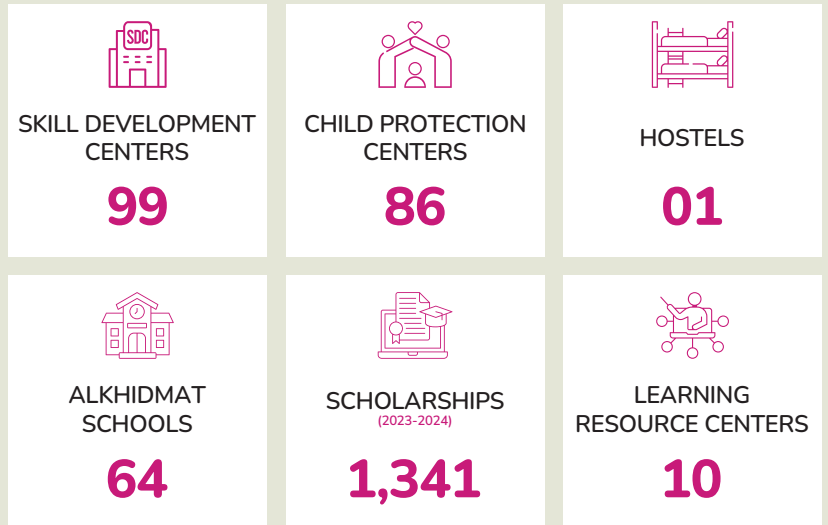

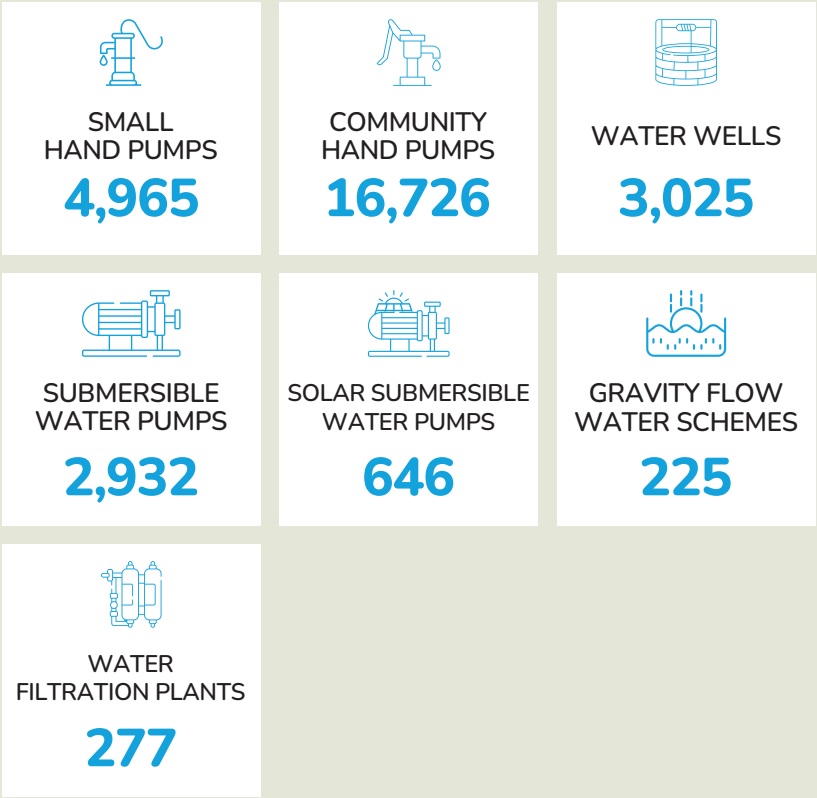

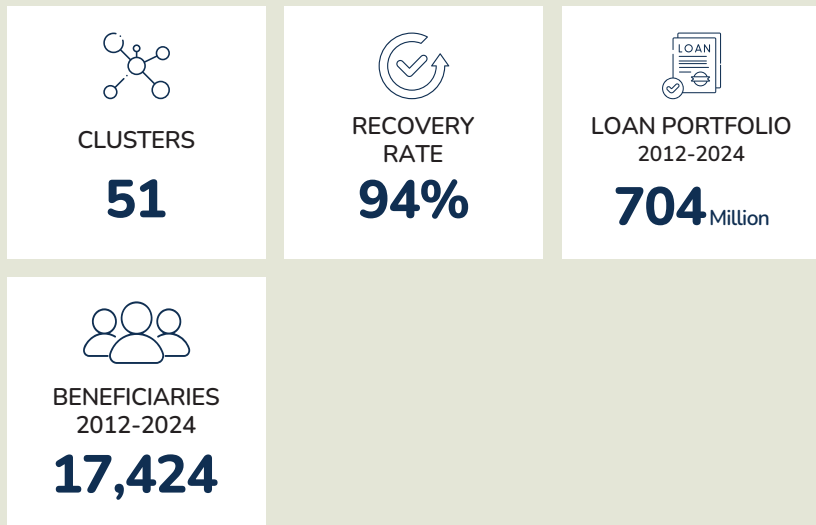

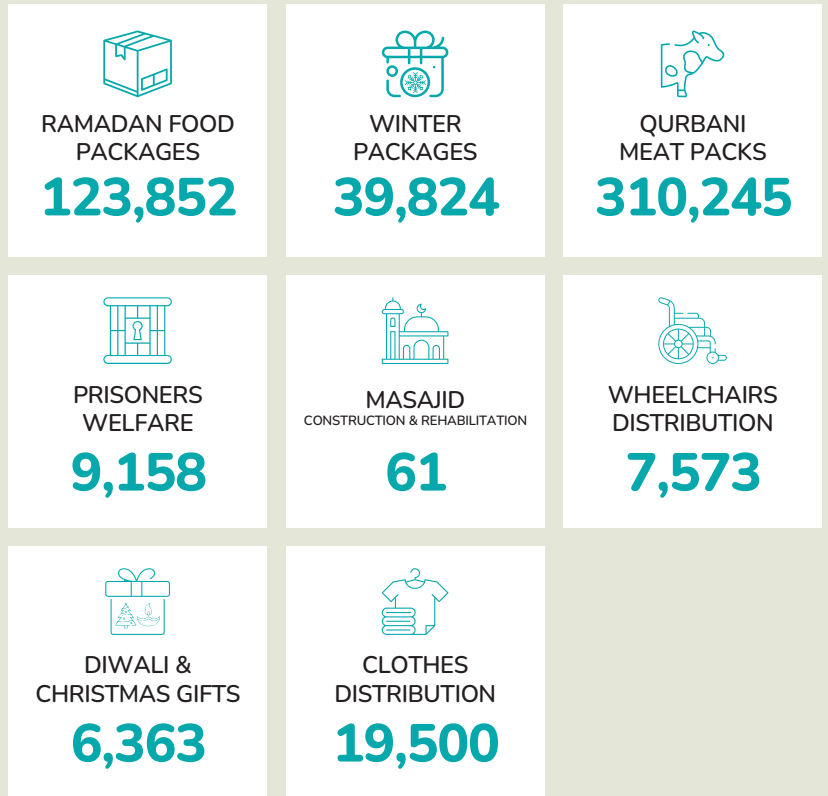

International Outreach

Response to the humanitarian crisis in Gaza remained a focal point of Alkhidmat International Affairs after over 2.2 million lives were put in a dire situation following October 7, 2023. Alkhidmat delivered thousands of tons of relief aid to Gaza. Beyond Gaza, Alkhidmat extended its international humanitarian efforts to Lebanon, Sudan, and Bangladesh, addressing urgent needs with tailored relief initiatives. These efforts were carried out in collaboration with international partners.

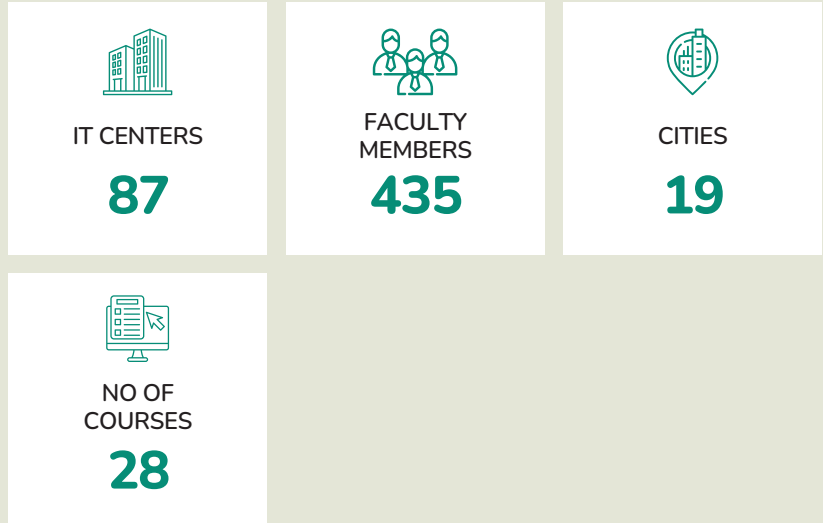
