Primary Themes

1. Education Recovery & Access

- ✓ Build or rehabilitate 50 child-friendly classrooms in displacement camps.
- ✓ Provide school materials, uniforms, and solar study lamps to 10,000 children.
- ✓ Establish alternative learning programs for out-of-school youth.

2. Child Protection & Safe Spaces

- ✓ Create 80 safe spaces for children to play, learn, and heal.
- ✓ Train 500 community child protection volunteers.
- ✓ Establish referral systems for cases of abuse, GBV, and exploitation.

3. Skills for Adolescents & Youth

- ✓ Train 3,000 older youth in vocational trades, digital literacy, and entrepreneurship.
- ✓ Provide startup kits for 400 youth-led businesses.

🔍 Project Summary

In Ethiopia's conflict-affected regions, millions of children have lost years of learning and face hunger, trauma, and the threat of exploitation. Without urgent action, this lost generation will face lifelong barriers to education, safety, and livelihoods.

Through *Brighter Futures*, FUGAO will combine education, protection, and skills-building to restore hope and opportunity for 10,000 displaced children and youth. By creating safe learning environments, feeding programs, and pathways to employment, this project ensures that no child is left behind in Ethiopia's recovery.

📌 Pressing Problem

- ✓ Over 3 million Ethiopian children are out of school due to conflict and displacement.
- ✓ Displaced children face high risks of child labor, early marriage, and exploitation.
- ✓ Hunger and trauma undermine learning and development.

This 4-year project will:

- ✓ Provide education and protection to 10,000 children in crisis zones.
 - ✓ Build or restore 50 classrooms and 80 safe spaces.
 - ✓ Train 3,000 youth in job-ready skills and connect them to work.
 - ✓ Deliver nutrition and mental health support to displaced learners.

Sustainability Plan
