## 🔍 Project Summary

Millions in Ethiopia face overlapping crises — armed conflict, displacement, climate shocks, and food shortages. Current humanitarian responses often end when immediate needs are met, leaving communities vulnerable to future crises.

The Ethiopia Resilience Hub project will establish five permanent, multi-service centers in high-need regions to provide health care, safe water, food security, skills training, and peace building programs. Each hub will be both a humanitarian lifeline and a development engine, helping over 500,000 people recover from crises and build sustainable futures.

- ✓ 20+ million Ethiopians require humanitarian assistance (OCHA, 2025).
- ✓ Recurring droughts and floods destroy livelihoods and deepen poverty.
