Displacement camps and conflict-affected communities in Oromia, Amhara, Afar, Somali, Benishangul-Gumuz, and Southern Ethiopia

Key Themes

Primary Themes

1. Mobile Health & Nutrition Services

- ✓ Deploy 8 fully equipped mobile clinics to reach remote, displaced populations.
- ✓ Provide maternal and child health services for 50,000 women and children.
- ✓ Screen and treat malnutrition in youth under 18.

2. Trauma Recovery & Mental Health Support

- ✓ Deliver trauma counseling to 10,000 conflict-affected youth and mothers.
- ✓ Train 200 community health workers in psychosocial support.
- ✓ Establish “Healing Corners” for safe expression and group therapy.

3. Youth Health Education & Prevention

- ✓ Launch youth health clubs in 150 schools and temporary learning centers.
- ✓ Provide GBV prevention training and reproductive health education to 5,000 youth.



- ✓ Distribute dignity kits for 20,000 adolescent girls.

4. Water, Sanitation & Hygiene (WASH)

- ✓ Install solar-powered water points in 20 displacement camps.
- ✓ Provide hygiene training and kits to 30,000 displaced people.
- ✓ Support school WASH facilities to prevent disease outbreaks.

🔍 Project Summary

In Ethiopia's crisis zones, mothers are giving birth without medical care, youth are succumbing to preventable diseases, and trauma remains untreated. Conflict has destroyed health facilities, displaced millions, and left young people vulnerable to poor health and exploitation.

Through *Healing Horizons*, FUGAO will bring life-saving mobile clinics, trauma recovery services, and health education directly to those who cannot reach a hospital. This holistic approach—combining physical health, mental wellness, and prevention—will give conflict-affected youth and mothers the care they need to survive, recover, and rebuild.

📍 Pressing Problem

- ✓ Over 1.1 million displaced people in Ethiopia have no regular access to healthcare.
- ✓ Maternal mortality in crisis zones is 3x higher than the national average.
- ✓ 1 in 4 children in displacement camps suffers from acute malnutrition.
- ✓ Mental health services are nearly nonexistent for trauma-affected youth.

🔥 Why This Matters

- ✓ Healthy youth are the foundation for Ethiopia's peace and progress.
- ✓ Untreated illness and trauma deepen cycles of poverty and violence.
- ✓ Mobile clinics can save lives where no hospital exists.



💡 Our Solution

This 4-year project will:

- ✓ Operate 8 mobile health clinics with skilled medical teams.
- ✓ Deliver maternal care, vaccinations, and nutrition programs.
- ✓ Provide trauma counseling and psychosocial support.
- ✓ Train youth as health ambassadors in their communities.
- ✓ Establish safe spaces and WASH facilities to improve health outcomes.

Expected Long-Term Impact by 2030

- ✓ 50,000 women and children access essential health care.
- ✓ 10,000 youth and mothers receive trauma recovery support.
- ✓ 200 trained community health workers sustain services post-project.
- ✓ 20 displacement camps equipped with clean water and WASH facilities.
- ✓ 5,000 youth trained as peer health educators.

Sustainability Plan

- ✓ Train and employ local health workers from beneficiary communities.
- ✓ Integrate mobile clinics into regional health bureau strategies.
- ✓ Maintain WASH facilities through community health committees.
- ✓ Build local capacity for mental health and health education.

Donation Options

- ✓ \$10 – Provides essential vitamins for 5 malnourished children.
- ✓ \$25 – Vaccinate 10 children against preventable diseases.
- ✓ \$50 – Provides dignity kits for 5 adolescent girls.
