🔑 Key Themes

Primary Themes

1. **Life-Saving Dialysis Support**

- ✓ Provide subsidies for dialysis sessions for 2,000 low-income patients.
- ✓ Supply dialysis kits, medicines, and essential consumables.
- ✓ Strengthen regional dialysis centers with equipment and staff training.

2. **Access to Medicines & Nutrition**

- ✓ Distribute life-saving drugs for chronic kidney disease (CKD) patients.
- ✓ Provide nutrition support packages (renal-friendly foods, supplements).
- ✓ Establish a patient assistance pharmacy scheme.

3. **Community & Family Support**

- ✓ Train 1,000 caregivers in patient care and hygiene.
- ✓ Establish 20 patient support groups and counseling programs.
- ✓ Provide psychosocial services for patients and families.



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4. **Awareness & Prevention**

- ✓ Nationwide campaigns on kidney health, early screening, and prevention.
- ✓ Screen 100,000 people for hypertension, diabetes, and kidney disease risks.
- ✓ Integrate awareness into schools, youth clubs, and community networks.

5. **Policy & Sustainability**

- ✓ Work with Ministry of Health to expand dialysis capacity.
- ✓ Advocate for inclusion of kidney care in Ethiopia's health insurance system.
- ✓ Build partnerships with hospitals, NGOs, and private labs.

🔍 Project Summary

Kidney disease is a silent crisis in Ethiopia, where thousands face death due to unaffordable dialysis and lack of medical care. Each dialysis session costs up to \$100, far beyond the reach of most families. The "Hope for Life" project will subsidize dialysis treatments, provide essential medicines, support nutrition, and strengthen hospital services across six regions. This 5-year initiative will save lives, improve quality of care, and bring hope to kidney patients and their families.

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📍 Pressing Problem

- ✓ Dialysis costs are unaffordable for most Ethiopians (average income <\$2/day).
- ✓ Limited dialysis machines and long waiting lists at referral hospitals.
- ✓ Many patients die prematurely due to lack of access to treatment.
- ✓ High prevalence of diabetes & hypertension increases kidney disease cases.

🔥 Why This Matters

- ✓ Dialysis is the only lifeline for patients with kidney failure.
- ✓ Affordable treatment saves lives, prevents families from falling into poverty.
- ✓ Improved access reduces mortality from non-communicable diseases.



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💡 Our Solution

Over 5 years, this project will:

- ✓ Provide 20,000 subsidized dialysis sessions for 2,000 patients.
- ✓ Supply essential medicines and consumables to dialysis centers.
- ✓ Support nutrition programs for 5,000 kidney patients.
- ✓ Screen 100,000 people for early kidney disease risks.
- ✓ Train 1,000 caregivers and establish support networks.
